

MedaPal Meda Collection





MedaPal concentrates on the essentials: It combines intelligent technology with great comfort. The construction of the chair is simple, Meda Pal is easy to use and can be quickly adapted according to individual requirements.

The backrest, which is moulded in a single piece, simultaneously offers support in the lower back area and flexibility in the shoulder region. The seat shell and armrest bridge are made out of polyamide using a new manufacturing technique. As a result, MedaPal is lightweight and comfortable, yet very strong. The effective use of new materials makes it possible to achieve economical solutions while maintaining high quality.

Alberto Meda, engineer and designer, was born in 1945, lives and works in Milan. Meda's collaboration with Vitra, which began in 1994. The expansion of the Meda Collection is an ongoing process, resulting in new products which complement previous designs.

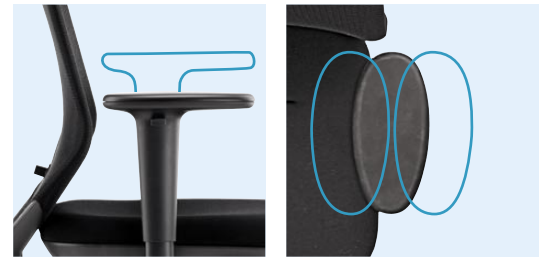




MedaPal is also available with the **optically thick cover** Torso Meda and in various colours.

The organic shape of the backrest, with the top edge angled slightly backward, offers greater **freedom of movement**.

A flexible knitted mesh fabric is stretched over the backrest frame. This adapts to the shape of the back and to the sitter's posture, providing support and **relieving pressure from the spine**. The mesh fabric offers excellent air circulation.



The armrests, which are adjustable in height and width, **reduce stress on muscles in the shoulder zone**.

The seat cushion, backrest and armrests can be replaced in just a few quick steps, without the use of specialised tools.

The **lumbar cushion** (optional) offers additional support. Its height can be adjusted to fit the shape of the individual's spine.

The new profiled seat cushion snaps into place on the moulded seat shell. The seat indentation and a slight rise in the rear of the cushion automatically bring the pelvis into an upright position. Therefore, in combination with the anatomical shape of the backrest, the lower back receives optimal support. The front edge of the seat is slanted downward in order to prevent pressure points. These features promote a **natural sitting position which is both comfortable and ergonomically correct**.

The individually adjustable synchronised mechanism provides a smooth range of movement and encourages dynamic seating habits. **The body receives optimal support in every sitting position**.

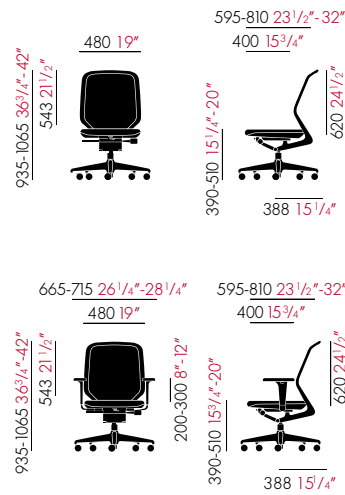
The back can be **locked in an upright position**.



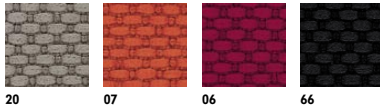
MedaPal Programme features

Office swivel chair according to EN 1335. Synchronised mechanism with large reclining angle. Fine tuning for individual weight adjustment. Backrest can be locked in the upright position. Optional lumbar cushion, adaptable to the height and contour of the lower back. Smooth adjustment of seat height with pneumatic safety spring. Frame, seat shell, armrests and base made of fibreglass-reinforced polyamide in a choice of colours; basic dark. Backrest: mesh fabric (Netline) stretched over the frame or knitted fabric Torso Meda. Profiled seat: cushion made of polyurethane foam with textile cover Nova (with seam) or knitted fabric Torso Meda. MedaPal with Torso cover for additional cost, also available with Clima Seat. Armrests optional, adjustable in height and width. Armrests pads made of thermoplastic elastomer in basic dark. Five-star base with hard castors for carpeting or soft castors for hard flooring (Ø 60 mm). MedaPal bears the ergonomic seal of approval from the LGA Nuremberg and the "Blue angel for low-emission upholstered furniture" label (RAL-UZ 117), which means that MedaPal was produced in an environmentally-friendly way, was checked for pollutants, and does not pose a threat to health.

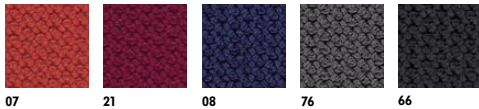
