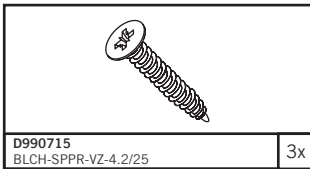
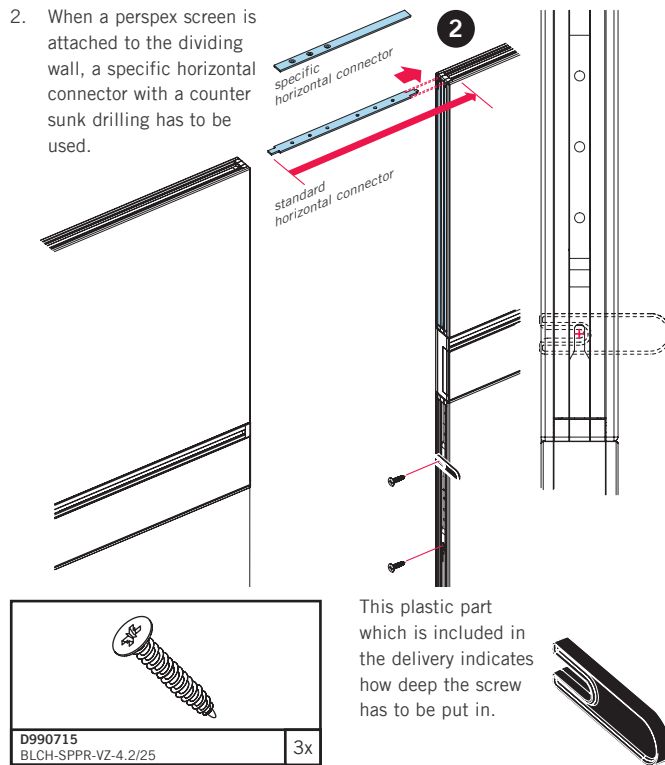
vertical cover profile preassembled.

In case of a horizontal connection, the visible cap has to be removed.

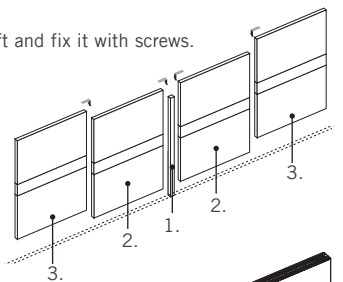
2. When a perspex screen is attached to the dividing wall, a specific horizontal connector with a counter sunk drilling has to be used.



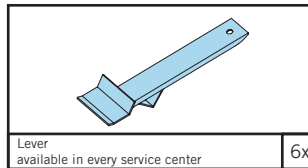
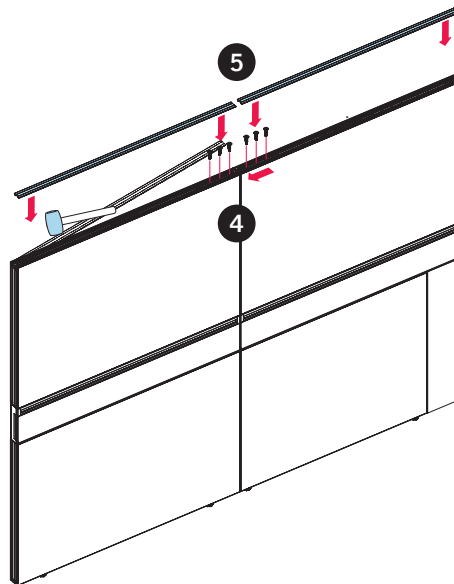
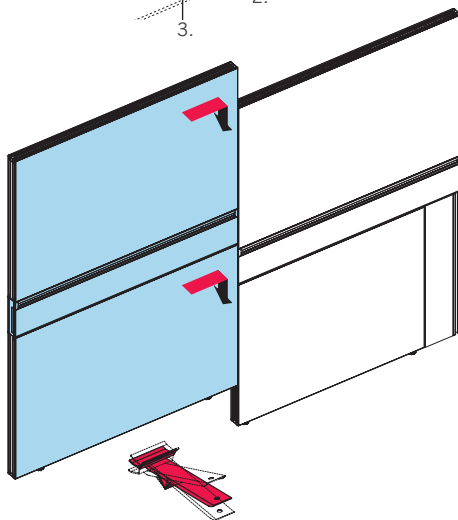
This plastic part which is included in the delivery indicates how deep the screw has to be put in.



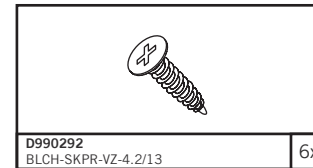
3. Link elements together.

5. Clip on cover profiles.



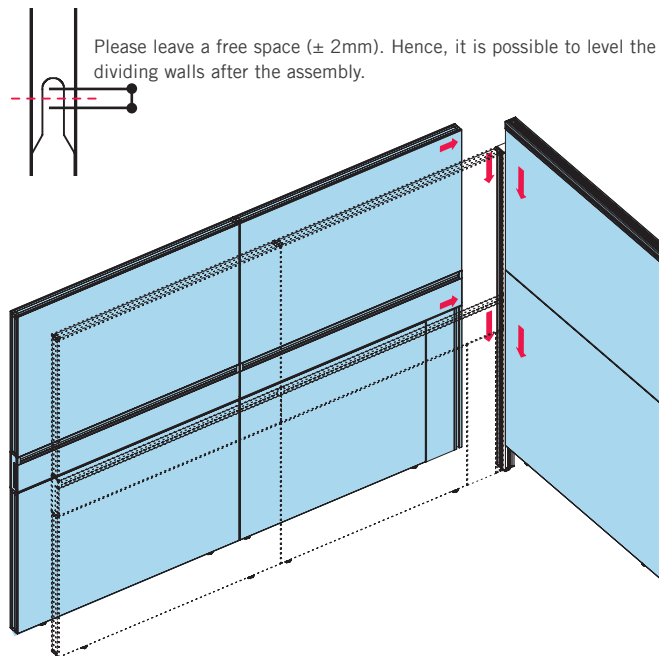
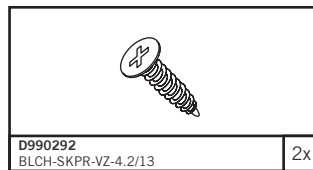
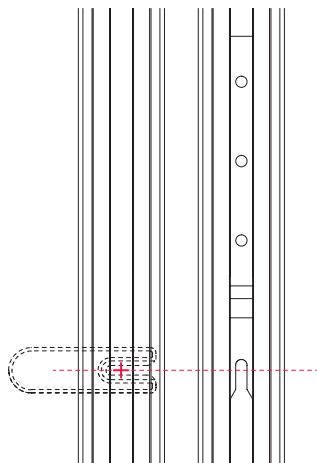
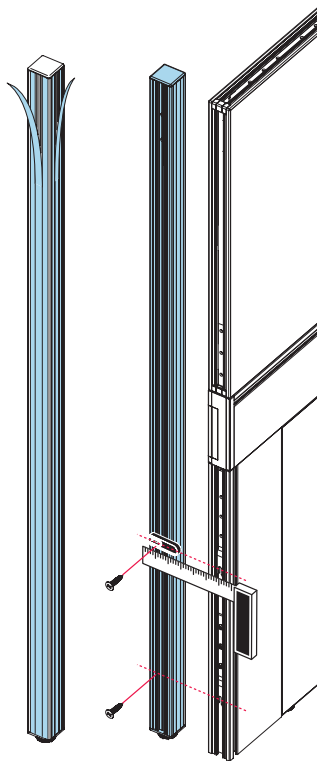

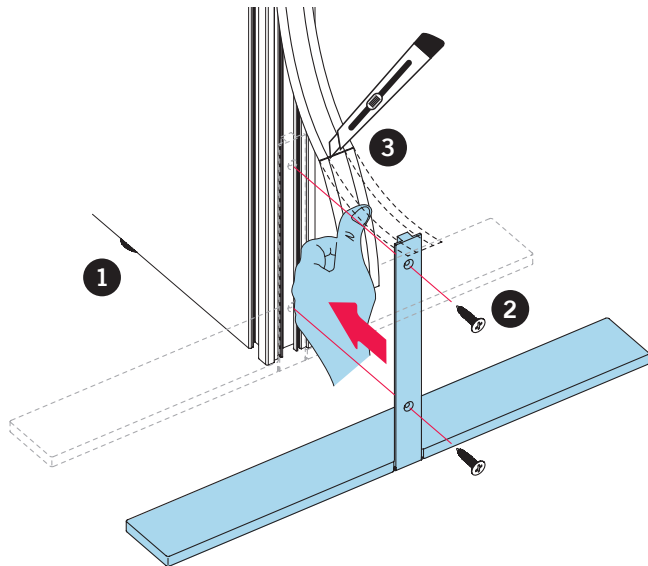
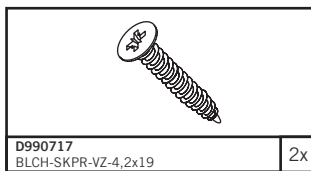
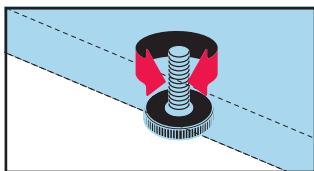




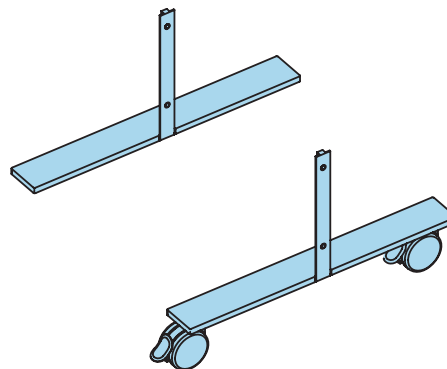
After levelling the elements, fix the corner junction with screws to the modules. This is due to secure the stability.

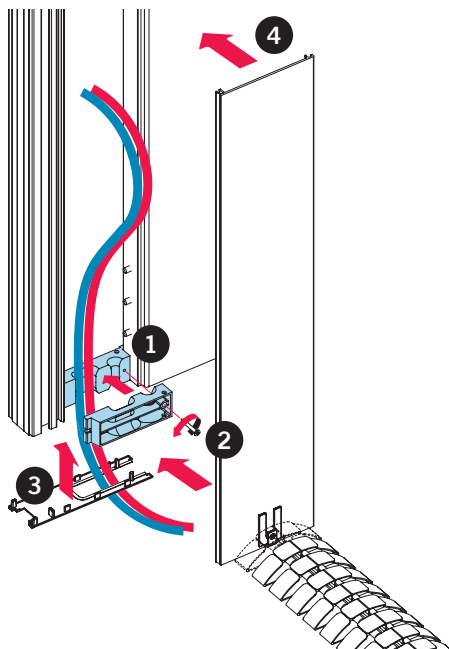

4. Screw adjustment leg. Thus, the leg cantilever carries the wall.

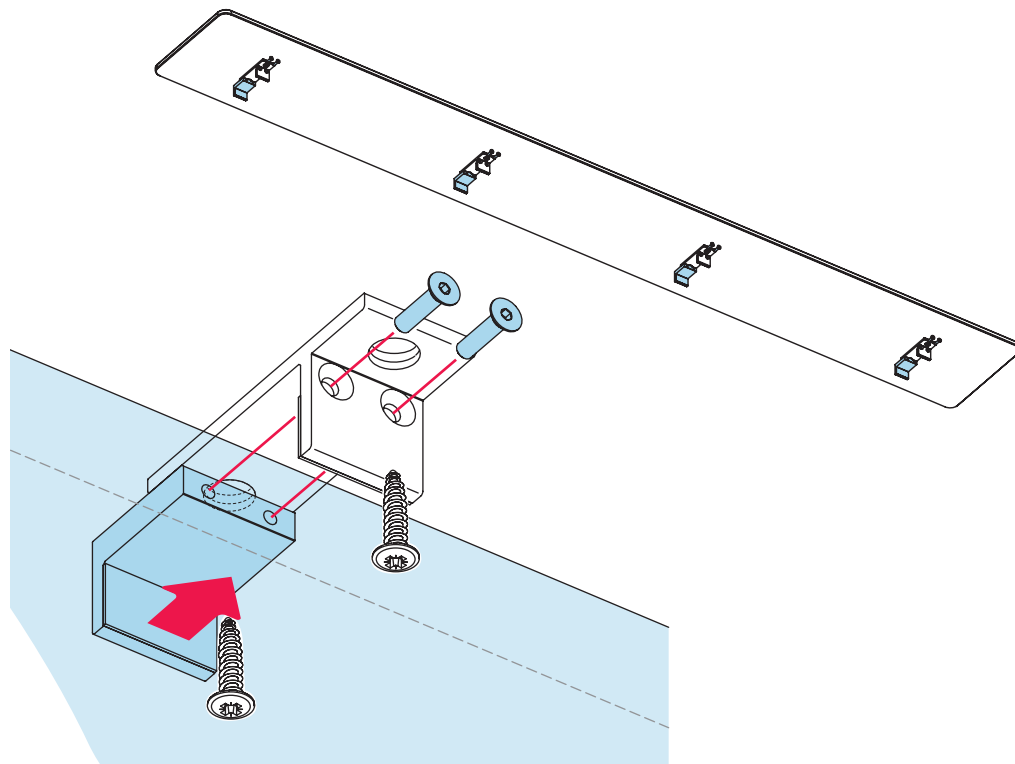
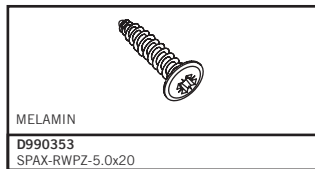
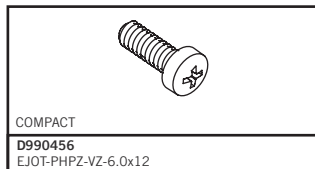


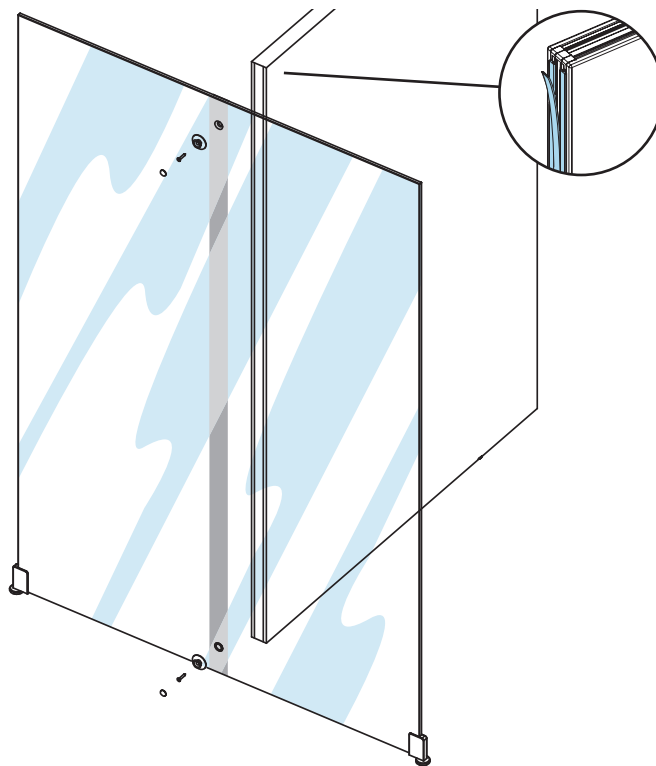
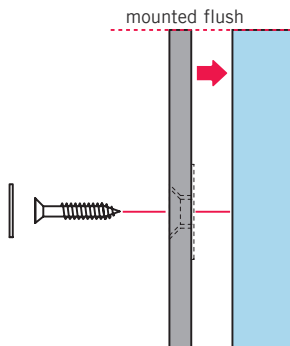
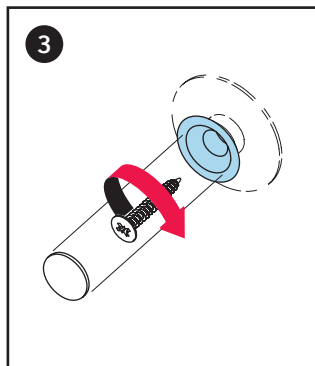
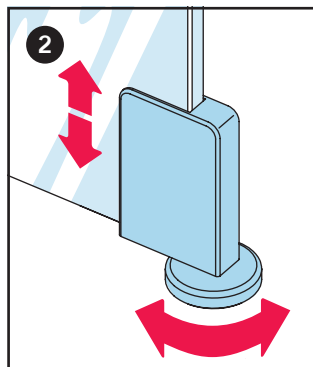
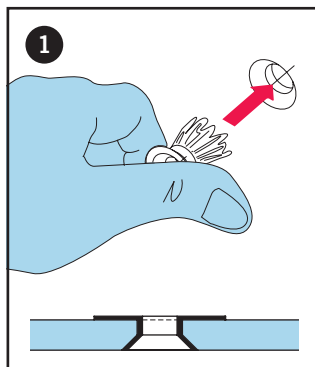

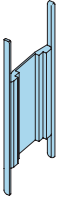
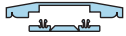








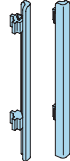
Cover profile with corner junction



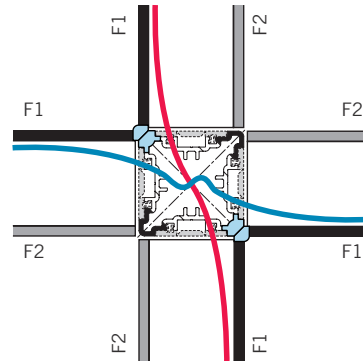
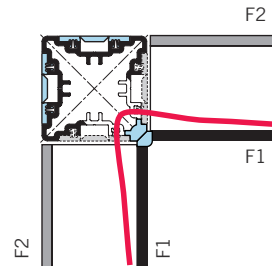
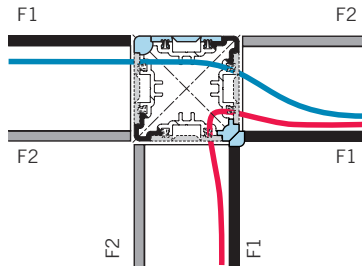
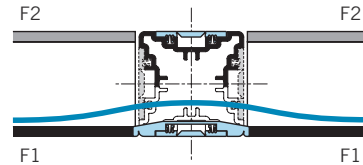
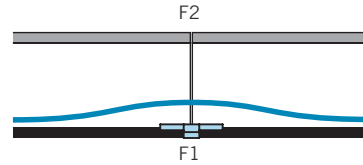
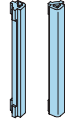
Cover profile without corner junction

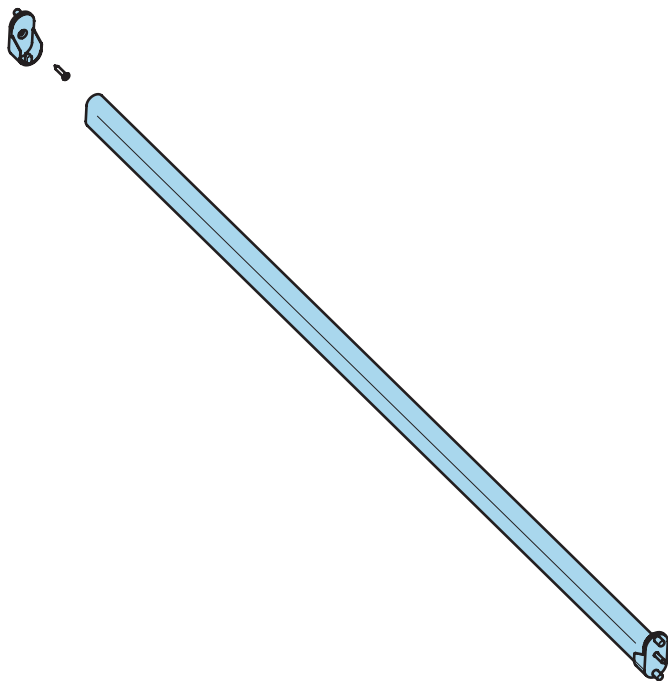


Inner corner cover profile

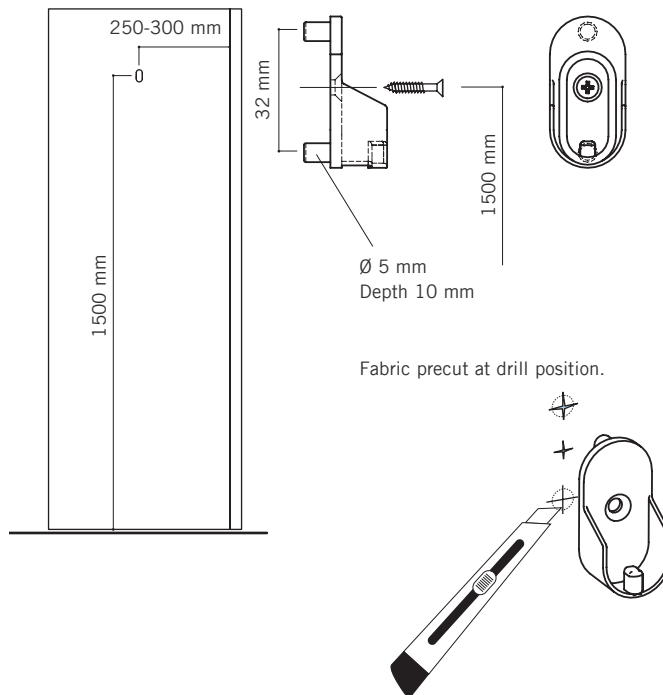


Exterior corner cover profile





Assembly instructions



Fabric precut at drill position.

Gentle and proper cleaning of furniture surfaces and partition walls is especially important in retaining their optimum condition for as long as possible.

We generally recommend cleaning with a moist, fluff-free cloth, moistened with pure water without the addition of any cleaning agents; furniture polishes or similar.

If cleaning with a damp cloth proves not to be adequate, careful use of a mild plastics cleaner without abrasive additive is admissible on melamine surfaces.

Wood polishes must not be used on open-pored lacquered veneer surfaces (oak, walnut, Macassar and Zebrano). This settles into the open pores, closes them and gives the surface a greasy, glossy appearance after a while. The desired semi-gloss and open-pored veneer appearance is ruined.

Furniture polishes available off-the-shelf can be used for closed-pore lacquered surfaces (cherry, beech and maple). They fill the finest of scratches in the lacquer and cover them up relatively well. An enhanced glossy appearance of the surface is difficult to prevent.

Never use polishes containing silicon, caustic cleaning agents with ammonia additives, alcohol or softeners. The same applies for scratching cleaning agents with abrasive additives.

Glass and material surfaces are to be cleaned in accordance with manufacturer's instructions. Please contact Bene for information and documentation on this matter.

Safety Instructions



Multiple socket outlets must be fixed correctly and located that way that the plugs can be plugged in and withdrawn easily. Plugs and multiple socket outlets must be positioned that way that in case of correct use of the office furnitures no liquids can flow into or on the electrical equipment.



The cables must be mounted tightly into the strain relief of the foot frame. Connection cables can be installed loose. All lines and cables must be installed that way that there is no danger of shearing off, abrasion or any other mechanical damages.



In case of working tables, which are equipped with movable working surfaces adjustable in height, special care is required. The cable lengths must be dimensioned sufficiently so that the movement of the working surfaces is possible without tensioning or pressing the cable.
