manufacturing technology

Our Middleton, TN facility is the location of the world's largest Salvagnini automated fabrication line. This state-of-the-art conveyor-to-assembly system produces the elevator entrances for our Machine Room-Less, hydraulic and traction product lines and is known for its automated flexibility, accuracy, speed and longevity as it can punch, form and cut a single piece of sheet metal into a finished entrance panel. The new system has the capacity to manufacture in excess of 80,000 entrances per year, while improving the scrap rate by 33%, another one of our steps toward sustainability.

Our Parts Warehouse and Distribution Center maintains the largest parts inventory in the industry. This, in conjunction with our service technician and branch locations, creates an extensive network of parts available 24/7.
