



Order Limitations

Products available to ship within ten business days are identified by a **10D** signifier. Minimum order quantities include: four (4) steel chairs, two (2) upholstered chairs or two (2) wood chairs. Maximum **10D** individual order quantities are forty (40) steel or wood chairs and forty (40) book racks or tablet arms. All unidentified products or larger quantities of **10D** chairs are available to ship within the standard lead time, six weeks. If your project requires a shorter lead time, contact your customer service representative for assistance. For orders over 200 chairs, please confirm shipment lead time on a case by case basis.

Terms and Conditions

Ordering Information

ORDER ACCEPTANCE:

American Seating is pleased to accept orders from authorized dealers and customers on the condition that all of the terms stated herein are applicable to the transaction. No additional or differing terms shall be applicable unless specifically agreed to in a separately signed document by authorized personnel at its offices in Grand Rapids, Michigan.

ORDER CONFIRMATION:

All orders are confirmed via facsimile and printed acknowledgment. Call 800-748-0268 to receive order confirmation information. Call 800-748-0317 to obtain leadtime information.

MINIMUM ORDER:

Add a minimum order charge of 10% of list price to orders under \$2,000.00 list price.

PRODUCT CHANGES:

American Seating reserves the right to change its products without notice, including changes in size to better interface with existing products or to incorporate changes needed for proposed new products.

ORDER INFORMATION:

All orders must be in writing from pre-approved, authorized dealers. Fax product orders to 616-732-6502. Orders will be acknowledged with American Seating's standard form showing approximate shipping date of items ordered. American Seating shall not incur any liability whatsoever for failure to ship on any specified ship date unless such date has been agreed to in a separate written document by authorized American Seating personnel in Grand Rapids, Michigan.

COMPLETE/ACCURATE ORDERING:

- Each item must be specified by color and number. Failure to provide adequate specification data shall absolve American Seating of all responsibility for incorrect shipment.
- All items other than American Seating's standard fabrics, laminates, wood veneers, and metal parts
 in standard colors and sizes will be considered non-standard or special order, and must be
 approved by authorized American Seating personnel in writing prior to order acceptance.

ORDER CHANGES AND CANCELLATION:

- After the date of acknowledgment, dealers and customers may not change or cancel their order (in whole or in part) without written approval from American Seating.
- Changes approved by American Seating shall be priced at current price levels, and American Seating may charge the customer for added costs which result from the change.
- Cancellations shall be subject to a minimum charge of fifteen percent (15%) of list price, and may
 be subject to reimbursement of American Seating for costs incurred prior to its approval of the
 cancellation.
- Orders for special products or non-standard products (including special colors, fabrics, finishes) are not subject to change or cancellation under any circumstances.

DEALER RIGHTS:

- American Seating reserves the right to reject any order placed by any customer for any reason (regardless of whether orders have been previously accepted from such customer), without incurring liability to such customer.
- No customer shall have a continuing right to buy products except pursuant to a formal dealer agreement or other written agreement covering future supply executed by American Seating and the customer

GOVERNING LAW:

The transaction with respect to the goods which are subject of the Acknowledgment shall be governed by and interpreted and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Michigan.

Pricing

PRICE CHANGES AND TAXES:

Published prices via print or electronic catalog are subject to change without notice. Published prices do not include storage, handling, local delivery charges, or installation – nor any applicable sales, use, excise or other similar taxes – all of which are the customer's responsibility.

TAX EXEMPT:

If a customer claims an exemption from such taxes, exemption certificate must be furnished to American Seating.

ADDITIONAL CHARGES:

Charges incurred subsequent to any bid/quotation and/or order acceptance (such as new taxes applicable to this order, changes in tax rate, freight surcharges, etc.) will be added by American Seating to the dealer or customer's invoice.

Pricing (cont.)

ADDITIONAL SERVICES:

Prices do not include interior design services nor field adjustments in the products except as may be provided under warranty. Field engineering services can be supplied at a per diem rate negotiated under separate agreement.

PAYMENT:

Payment in full is due thirty (30) days from the date of invoice. American Seating reserves the right to modify in whole or in part its credit arrangements if at any time prior to shipment the customer's financial condition is judged to be inadequate to justify existing credit arrangements or its manufacture is delayed at customer requests. Interest on past due accounts shall accrue and be paid at the maximum rate permitted by law at the place of the customer's business.

Shipping and Delivery

SHIPMENT:

- The shipping date shown on the face of the order acknowledgment represents American Seating's best estimate as of the date of the acknowledgment. This date is predicated on the timely submission of all information, approvals, clarifications, and all samples requested in writing by American Seating.
- American Seating shall not incur any liability of any kind whatsoever for failure to ship on any particular date unless American Seating has expressly agreed to a firm ship date in a separately signed, written instrument by authorized personnel in Grand Rapids, Michigan.

DELIVERY:

- Goods shall be shipped F.O.B. factory freight prepaid and allowed to points within the 48 contiguous states, and American Seating reserves the right to select the carrier and mode of shipment.
- Extra costs incurred due to special shipping instructions from the customer will be charged to the customer.
- Risk of loss shall pass to the customer when the goods are placed in the hands of a carrier.

EXAMINATION OF GOODS:

• The customer shall be responsible for examination of goods upon receipt and processing of any claims with the carrier.

CLAIMS:

Claims against American Seating for patent defects, errors or shortages must be made within fifteen (15) days of receipt of goods, otherwise such claims shall be deemed to have been waived. Partial deliveries shall be accepted by the customer and paid for at the contract price and terms.

STORAGE:

- If a customer requests a delay in shipment after the goods have become work in process, American
 Seating may place the finished goods in storage at the customer's risk and expense. Transfer to storage
 shall be deemed delivery for all purposes, including invoicing and payment.
- Any delays, holds or rescheduling of this order at the request of the customer will subject this order to the
 prices and conditions of sale in effect at the time of release of the hold or reschedule.

LOSS, DAMAGE OR DELAY:

In no event shall American Seating be liable for any loss or damage resulting from any delay or failure in shipment or other failure to perform with respect to the goods shown on the face hereof where such delay, failure, loss or damage is the proximate result of any act of any government authority, revolution, riot, civil disorder or disturbance, act of enemies, delay or default in transportation, strike disputes among or between labor unions or other labor disputes, inability to obtain materials or facilities from normal sources, fire, flood, act of God or any cause not within the reasonable control of American Seating whether of the class or causes enumerated or otherwise. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, American Seating may, without causing a breech or incurring liability, allocate goods which are in short supply irrespective of the reasons therefore, among customers in any manner which American Seating in its sole discretion, deems advisable.

RETURNS:

- Returns will not be accepted without prior written authorization and compliance with shipping instructions by American Seating. All goods must be returned on a prepaid basis.
- A minimum restocking charge of fifteen percent (15%) of list price is made on all authorized returns for credit, providing the item is received in resalable condition. An additional charge will be made for repair.
- Credit will not be given if any item cannot be reused. Special order items are not subject to return.

Product Warranty

Warranty

The Original 40/4 Stack Chairs (offered in joint partnership with OSI) are warranted to be free from defects in material and workmanship for five (5) years from the date of original shipment. The warranty is given to the initial purchaser of new products from American Seating and is non-transferable.

Products will be repaired or replaced with comparable product. Any product or component manufactured after June 15, 2009 that fails under normal use according to the following schedule:

From original shipment date:

- First year: 100% of all costs of replacement or repair of the defective furniture item or component, excluding on-site labor.
- Two years to five years: 50% of the cost of replacement furniture item or component, excluding on-site labor.

Normal use is defined as the equivalent of single shift, forty-hour workweek. Products used in excess of a single shift, forty-hour workweek, the appropriate warranty period will be prorated accordingly.

The materials and components listed below are exceptions:

One year warranty: glides, foam, laminates, wood veneer, veneer finishes, polymer based components, seating
upholstery fabrics, contoured tablet arm attachment, 40/4 chair dolly.

Warranty exclusions:

- Normal wear and tear (includes scratching/marring of stack chair seats, backs and frames due to normal use as well as stacking and ganging).
- Freight damage matters are addressed and resolved outside the scope of this product warranty.
- User modified products
- Unapproved attachments to products
- Product not installed or used in accordance with the installation and/or application guides for normal and proper use.
- Customers Own Material (COM)
- Exposure to climate and/or HVAC extremes
- Differences in grain characteristics, color and other features within and between wood species or other materials, which are naturally occurring variations.

NO WARRANTIES, EITHER EXPRESSED OR IMPLIED, EXCEPT AS EXPRESSLY SET FORTH ABOVE. No liability for incidental or consequential damages.

Customer's Own Material General Information

Specifying and Planning

Customer's Own Material (COM) Customer's Own Leather (COL)

The COM/COL program allows customers to use special upholstery materials. By complying with COM upholstery testing processing, we will be able to identify if your fabric or leather is appropriate for application to the products you specify.

If you elect to bypass the upholstery testing process, you may send a 12" x 12" sample for evaluation or decline to submit any sample for evaluation. However, if you elect to decline the testing process to determine the appropriateness of the COM/COL for the application, the manufacturer assumes no liability to the performance or appearance of the upholstery. If you elect to comply with the upholstery testing process please follow the procedures outlined below:

- 1. Select the COM/COL fabric.
- 2. Call your American Seating Customer Service Representative to obtain a COM/COL test number. A 11/4 yard sample is required for testing. Seat requires 3/4 yard and the back 1/2 yard.
- 3. Label fabric with the name of the fabric/leather manufacturer, the name and number of the pattern and color, the direction the fabric is to be applied, and the product numbers designated for the COM/COL application. Ship the sample to:

Note: All packaging labels must contain your COM/COL test number.

- 4. You will be notified within five (5) working days whether your fabric has been approved or disapproved for application.
- 5. If your fabric is approved, submit your purchase order with the COM/COL number.
- 6. When you receive your acknowledgement, note the order number and COM/COL ID number and include it with your fabric/leather when it is shipped to the factory. Products are scheduled for production after COM/COL yardage for the order has been received. Standard lead times in effect at that time will apply to the order.

Note: Yardage requirements listed in the price list are based on non-directional, 54" wide material. For other widths or large COM requirements contact your American Seating Customer Service Representative.

Note: When converting fabric yardage requirements to leather requirements – one yard of 50" to 54" fabric equals 22 square feet of leather.

Note: Customer is responsible for submitting yardage from which 100% yield can be obtained. Should fabric be flawed or if shortages occur, customer will be required to submit additional yardage.
