The Alton bench takes its cue from the angular rooflines and portico details of Miami Modern (MiMO), a style that had its heyday in the 1950s and early 60s. The sweeping architectural lines of the MiMO style are evident in the Alton bench's continuous stainless steel legs. The fine detailing of its tightly sculpted seat have a timeless appeal that brings elegance to lobbies, lounges, libraries, and museums.
