


SHIELDS Ornamental tablet.




MEDALLIONS
OVAL OR CIRCULAR TABLET.




CARTOUCHE

SURROUNDED WITH ORNAMENTAL SCROLLWORK.








PARAPET A LOW, PROTECTIVE WALL AT THE EDGE OF A TERRACE, BALCONY, OR ROOF.

BALCONY
A RAILED OR BALUSTRADED PLATFORM THAT
PROJECTS FROM A WALL, TYPICALLY IN FRONT
OF A DOOR OR WINDOW.

TERMINOLOGY COMMONLY USED AT BOSTON VALLEY TERRA COTTA



HEADER

THE UPPERMOST UNITS OF A WINDOW OR DOOR FRAME.

A FINISHED OR PROTECTIVE CAP OR COURSE TO AN EXTERIOR WALL, USUALLY SLOPED OR CURVED TO SHED WATER.

TRACERY DETAIL

ORNAMENTAL WORK OF BRANCHLIKE LINES. ESP. THE LACY OPENWORK IN THE UPPER PART OF A GOTHIC WINDOW.

EITHER OF THE TWO SIDE PIECES OF

DENTIL-

A SERIES OF RECTANGULAR CLOSELY SPACED BLOCKS FORMING A MOLDING.

MODILLION-

AN ORNAMENTAL BRACKET, USUALLY IN THE FORM OF A SCROLL, USED IN SERIES.


WATER TABLE

A PROJECTING STRING COURSE, MOLDING, OR LEDGE PLACED AS SO TO DIVERT RAINWATER FROM A BUILDING.

A CONTINUOUS, USUALLY PROJECTING COURSE OF STONES FORMING THE BASE OR FOUNDATION OF A WALL

PLINTH

SILL THE HORIZONTAL PIECES BENEATH A DOOR OR WINDOW OPENING.




FINIAL

A RELATIVELY SMALL, USUALLY FOLIATED ORNAMENT TERMINATING THE PEAK OF A SPIRE OR PINNACLE.

DORMER

A PROJECTING STRUCTURE BUILT OUT FROM A SLOPING ROOF, USUALLY HOUSING A VERTICAL WINDOW OR VENTILATING LOUVER.



BUTTRESS

AN INCLINED BAR OF MASONRY CARRIED ON A SEGMENTAL ARCH TRANSMITTING DOWNWARD THRUST FROM THE ROOF TO A SOLID BUTTRESS THAT THROUGH ITS MASS TRANSFORMS THE THRUST INTO A VERTICAL ONE.

GARGOYLE

A GROTESQUELY CARVED FIGURE ESP. ONE WITH AN OPEN MOUTH THAT SERVES AS A SPOUT TO THROW RAINWATER CLEAR OF A BUILDING.
