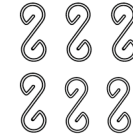
(3) Double Scroll Rods



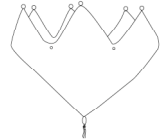
(1) Medium Ring

### Assembly:

First read and install your ceiling fixture by using the CEILING FIXTURE WIRING INSTRUCTIONS included in your pendant installation kit.

1. This instruction sheet explains how to hang the shade frame and fabric shade.
2. **(figure 1)** With the pendant cord and 2 rings hanging straight down, hook the scroll rods to the two rings. Use the connected end of the scroll on the large spoke ring **(figure 2)**.
3. **(figure 2)** The scrolls should straddle both sides of the spoke.
4. **(figure 3)** Hang the six S-hooks onto the large spoke ring. Use two S-hooks between each spoke. Make sure all the S-hooks are facing inward and are spaced out evenly with two between each spoke.
5. **(figure 4)** Hang the medium ring from all six S-hooks.
6. **(figure 5)** Hook each of the six holes of the fabric shade to the six S-hooks from inside the medium ring. Drape the flaps over the outside of the medium ring.
7. Install a 200-Watt bulb, turn on, and enjoy!

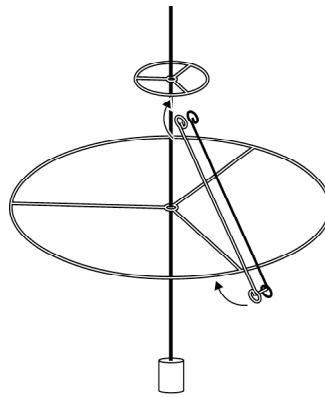

##### **Fabric shade . . .**

This shade is made of dupioni silk or hemp muslin. To remove dust from fabric shades, remove shade and shake the dust out of it. Shades may also be dry-cleaned. Shades should be ironed on the lowest setting possible with a steam iron or using a dry iron and a press-cloth.
