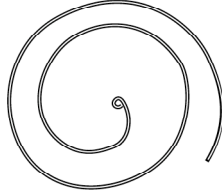

## Assembly Instructions

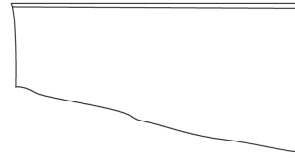
### Parts Included: (pictures not to scale)



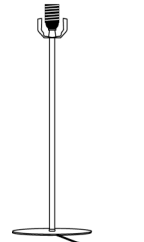
(1) Harp with Ball Finial



(1) Spiral Shade Frame



(1) Fabric Shade



(1) Lamp Base

### Assembly:

1. **(figure 1)** Attach harp assembly by squeezing the prongs into the harp sleeves below the socket.
2. **(figure 2)** Secure the spiral frame to the harp with the brass ball finial.
3. **(figure 3)** Starting with the wide end of the shade, thread the end of the spiral shade frame into the hem along the top of the shade. (Note: The hem is sewn shut on the short end of the shade.) Continue until the whole shade is threaded onto the frame.
4. Install a 75 watt bulb, turn on, and enjoy!

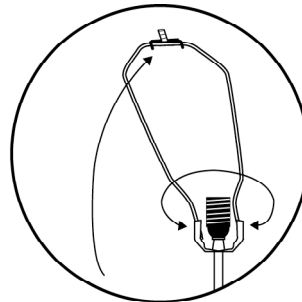

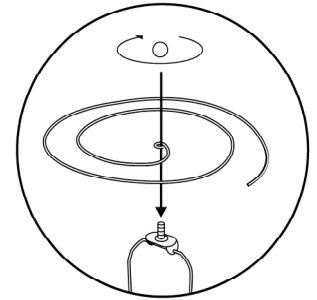

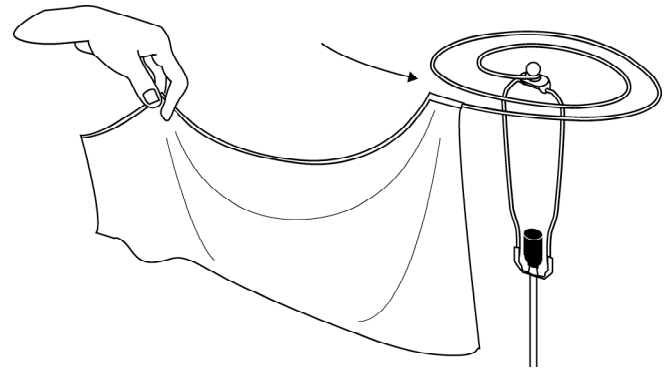

### SAFETY AND CARE INFORMATION

#### SAFETY

We have designed your lamp to the highest safety standards and all of our lamps are UL and CUL Approved. This portable lamp has a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other) as a feature to reduce electric shock. This plug will fit in a polarized outlet only one way. If the plug does not fit fully in the outlet, reverse the plug. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician. Never use with an extension cord unless plug can be fully inserted. Do not alter the plug.

#### CARE

##### **Fabric shade . . .**

Turn the light on to remove any wrinkles from the shade. The shade is made of silk and may be ironed with a cool iron and washed in cold water and allowed to air dry, or may be dry cleaned.
