Archive Zone

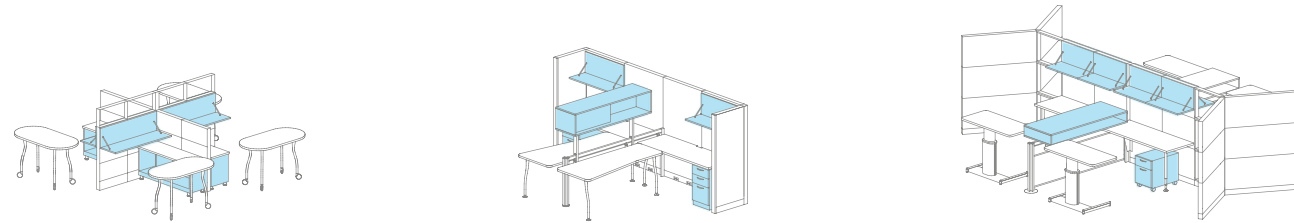
Files you'll never think about again until you really do need them or you get promoted

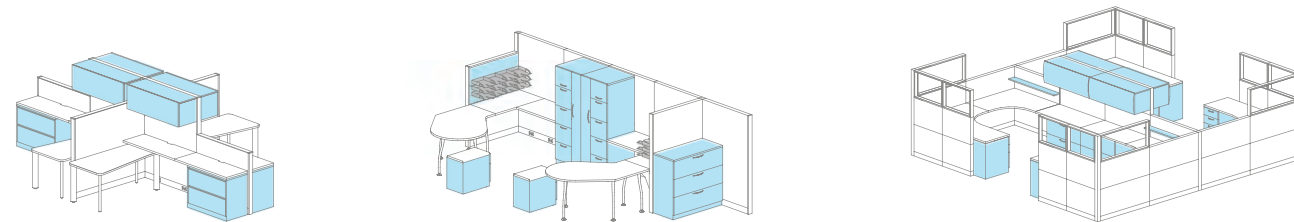
Visual Filers

Out of sight, out of mind. These people need to see their stuff to keep up with it. Shallow workspaces and open shelves should be a nice fit.



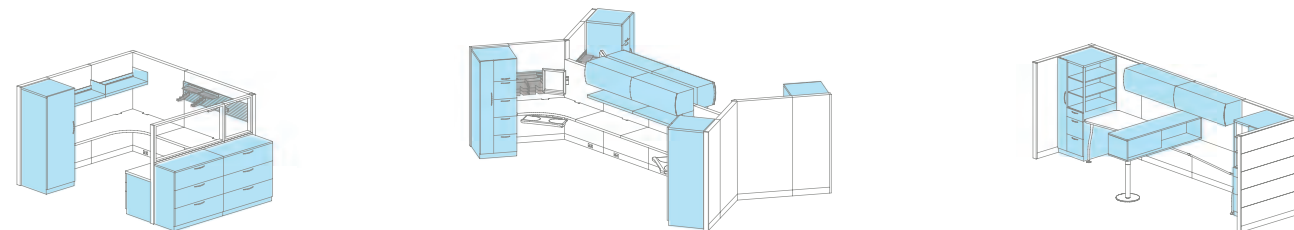
Clean Desk Filers
