The repeating elements of Palmer tables create a mirror effect; it is as though the tapered legs and solid top are reflected at the base. This is not surprising given the tables are named after a seaside hotel in Miami's South Beach. 



Specifications

Side, coffee and console tables are available in maple veneers and solids with wood, painted glass or white solid surface tops.

- Top: A maple veneer top is standard. .5" thick Glacier White solid surface or .25" thick painted glass in a range of colors is also available.
