When Alberto Meda developed MedaPal, he focused on what was essential: he created an office swivel chair with a light look that combined intelligent technology with great sitting comfort. The chair has a simple design and it is user-friendly. The chair is made up of only a few parts that are of extremely high quality, which makes it a perfect economical, ecological and robust addition to any office.

## Comfort

An innovative feature of MedaPal is its backrest frame which is moulded in a single piece using the latest developments in plastic technology. In addition to its loose net weave cover, the chair has been designed to offer support to the lumbar area of the lower back, while the formed and indented seat ensures that the user's pelvis remains straight. The chair is extremely user-friendly, and this means that it can be adjusted easily for instant comfort. It is almost impossible to adjust the chair in the wrong way.

## Economical

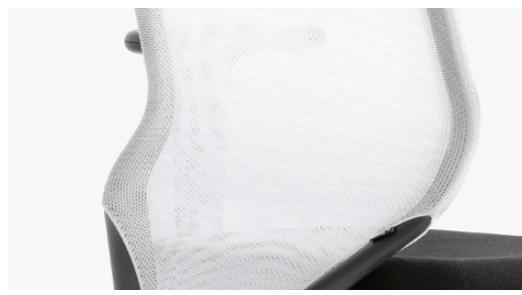
MedaPal offers you ergonomical sitting comfort and all the adjustments that you need in a high quality and durable chair. It is an extremely economical office swivel chair that consists of only a few parts, which makes it easy to maintain. In addition, the backrest, seat cushions and armrests can easily be replaced.

## Ecology

MedaPal was the very first office swivel chair to be awarded the "Blue Angel" environmental seal and is also GREENGUARD certified. MedaPal is made of up to 35% recycled materials and can be re-recycled up to 94%.



The chair's synchronised mechanism can be adjusted to different user weights, which ensures easy and free body movement as well as plenty of support while sitting in any position.



The innovative backrest frame offers users free body movement.



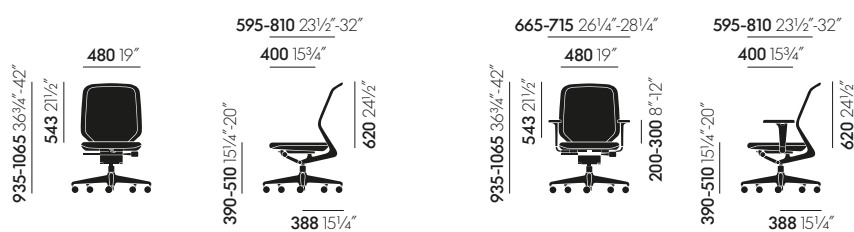
Both the height and the width of the armrests can be adjusted.



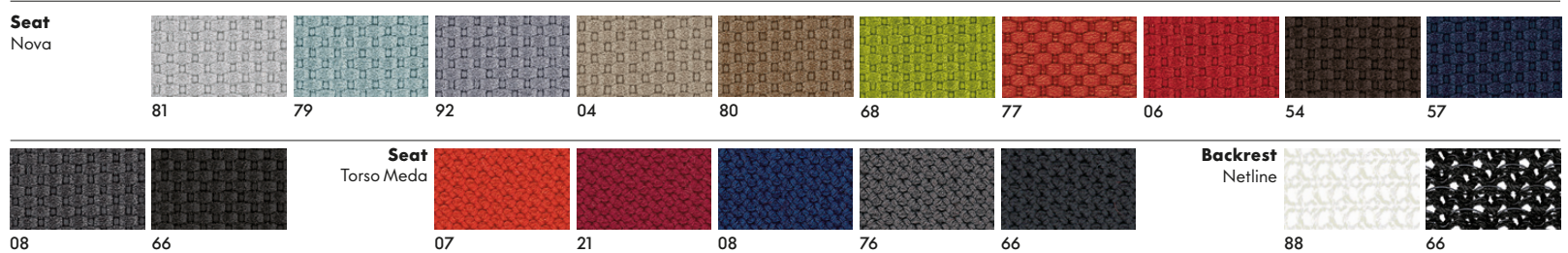
The indented seat cushion provides high sitting comfort.

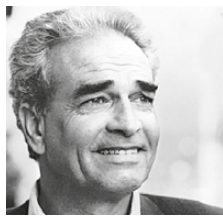
