Armstrong linoleum contains 35% preconsumer recycled content in the form of wood dust and cork flour. The Armstrong Linoleum plant has an aggressive program to reuse all internal plant scrap and reduce environmental emissions to air and solid waste.

### MR Credit 6: Rapidly Renewable Materials

Armstrong Linoleum contains 36% by weight rapidly renewable content comprised of linseed oil and jute backing.
