Re: Potential LEED credits for projects using Combination (based on LEED-NC, version 3)

To whom it may concern:

Indoor Environmental Quality Credit 4.3 (1 point): Low-Emitting Materials - Flooring Systems Combination meets the requirements of the Resilient Floor Covering Institute's FloorScore program. Combination is FloorScore certified. Combination may contribute to LEED IEQ Credit 4.3.

Materials & Resources Credit 4 (1 - 2 points): Recycled Content

Combination is manufactured from both pre-consumer and post-consumer materials. Combination may contribute to LEED MR Credit 4.

- 100% Black tiles have 90.1% post-consumer recycled content.
- Tiles with 20% intensity have 87.4% post-consumer and 0.5% pre-consumer recycled content.
- Tiles with 50% intensity have 82.9% post-consumer and 1.4% pre-consumer recycled
- Tiles with 90% intensity have 74.9% post-consumer and 3% pre-consumer recycled content.

Materials & Resources Credit 5 (1 - 2 points): Regional Materials

The manufacturing facilities are located in British Columbia, Canada. Depending upon the project location, using these products may qualify for LEED MR Credit 5.
