## Indoor Environmental Quality Credit 4.1 (1 point): Low Emitting Materials: Adhesives & Sealants

Mats Inc. Urethane Bond adhesive has a low VOC content (45 g/L) which reduces the quantity of indoor air contaminants. The VOC limit required by LEED for Rubber Floor adhesive is 60 g/L. Urethane Bond adhesive may contribute to LEED IEQ Credit 4.1.

Indoor Environmental Quality Credit 4.3 (1 point): Low-Emitting Materials - Flooring Systems Panorama Tile meets the requirements of the Resilient Floor Covering Institute's FloorScore program. Panorama Tile is FloorScore certified. Panorama Tile may contribute to LEED IEQ Credit 4.3.

## Materials & Resources Credit 2 (1 - 2 points): Construction Waste Management

Panorama Tile is manufactured from materials that can be diverted from disposal, recycled and returned to the manufacturing process for reuse. Panorama Tile may contribute to LEED MR Credit 2.

## Materials & Resources Credit 4 (1 - 2 points): Recycled Content

Panorama Tile is manufactured from both pre-consumer and post-consumer materials. Recycled content varies by color. Please contact Customer Service for specific recycled content information. Panorama Tile may contribute to LEED MR Credit 4.

## Materials & Resources Credit 5 (1 - 2 points): Regional Materials

The manufacturing facilities are located in British Columbia, Canada. Depending upon the project location, using these products may qualify for LEED MR Credit 5.
