

Redondo, a seating range which Patricia Urquiola designed for Moroso in 2010, is a combination of two volumes: an upholstered shell that completely envelops the large seat cushions. A bold departure from static, linear shapes to recommence with roundness.

A distinctive collection, starting with its name, which means "round" in Spanish. An enclosed yet open space, a roundness that becomes a cavity, a return to the origins which evokes the protective intimacy of a hug.

Redondo is independent of its context, it requires a certain amount of space around it to appreciate its roundness.

It is a private yet shared place where a tendency towards simplicity uses space in the most harmonious way.

A large sofa, a small sofa and two armchairs. The viewer sees them as a stage on which little everyday stories are played out, a place of shelter where we can seek sanctuary from the frenetic pace of city life.

Redondo Beach

Situated on the coast just 20 km from the centre of Los Angeles, Redondo Beach has for over a century been the preferred destination of those who seek the sun and the sea to escape from the frantic pace of the city. Modern hotels distinguish the beachfront area, but the original, early-20th-century wooden buildings in pastel colours still grace the centre of town with its relaxed, informal, typically Californian

atmosphere.

A soft sofa with no sharp edges

A complete lack of sharp edges adds to the beauty of Redondo's soft shape, as does the soft, tactile upholstery enhanced by a quilted pattern in which, like a pencil, the thread draws an elegant, three-dimensional design.

Redondo's enclosed yet open shape creates a space in its own right, self-organised, a place for relaxing the mind and body, a parallel dimension where we can create time for ourselves and others. A sofa to enjoy with our loved ones, a slow pleasure transforming conviviality into fondness.

The sofa is shaped rather like a brandy glass and does not need lots of loose cushions. It is a combination of two volumes, a seat enclosed in a protective shell, evoking the classical spirit of the ideal shape

Quilted pattern that stimulates the senses



Made in Italy with superior-quality certified materials

Redondo means streamlined simplicity, material quality, solid construction and manufacturing technology complexity. Although the main impression is of a snug, cushiony shelter, we nevertheless perceive the sofa's solid construction.

The shell is a metal structure with cold-cured foam and polyester fibre. This makes the sofa soft to touch, including the back panel. Although it is made industrially, the many meticulous, hand-executed finishing touches make Redondo a product of fine tailoring.

In her design work, she always looks for solutions that will create an intimate, informal, comfortable setting that consumers can adapt to their taste.



REDONDO

Redondo sofas and modular units are made of different-density resilient polyurethane foam and polyester fibre over an internal wooden frame. The armchair and small armchair are made of fire-retardant, coldcured foam over an internal steel frame. The polypropylene feet are screwed into the frame. The different-density polyurethane foam padding is CFC-free. The optional backrest cushions are padded with goose feather. The collection's fabric upholstery is quilted according to an exclusive pattern by the designer Patricia Urquiola. The Redondo range has fully removable covers with the exception of

CARE AND USE

code no. 061 armchair.

Redondo seating is intended solely for indoor use. Do not stand on the seats or sit or jump on the back and armrests as this may cause breakage. When moving the seating for any distance whatsoever, do not drag it along the floor: lift it instead to avoid damage to the frame and to the floor itself. Protect the parts that touch the floor from knocks and contact with water or cleaning products containing corrosive chemicals. For routine cleaning, brush the chair regularly

with a soft brush and, if needed, gently wipe the fabric with a damp cloth. The goose-feather cushions should be plumped often to air them and ensure they keep their shape over time.

Every type of fabric or leather has specific qualities: for non-routine care follow the instructions given in the warranty.

DISPOSAL

At product end of life, separate upholstery and structural parts as much as possible to facilitate recycling and disposal operations. Most of the materials used for manufacturing Moroso products can be recycled. Arrangements should be made with local waste management and recycling services for disposal, making sure that the procedures implemented comply with current legislation in the relevant country.










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
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Cod.032/033 Lateral 3 seat unit left/right


