2 CONSTRUCTION WASTE MANAGEMENT	
Orders of more than \$50,000 net are blanket wrapped when delivered directly to the installation site. Standard packing materials include corrugated cardboard and plastic shrinkwrap, which are recyclable in many markets and can reduce landfill.	
50% minimum of debris to be recycled or salvaged	1
75% minimum of debris to be recycled or salvaged	2
3.2 MATERIALS REUSE—FURNITURE AND FURNISHINGS	1
Geiger products are designed for durability with a 12-year warranty, and can be reused on many building projects. LEED credit can be earned when using salvaged, refurbished or used furniture and furnishings for 30% of the total furniture and furnishings budget.
