

## Can the Digital Glass Portfolio images be modified?

Yes. Please consult with your Skyline Design sales representative to review your requirements.

## What is the thickness of Portfolio glass?

Glass thickness options include: 1/4", 3/8", 1/2", 3/4".

#### Are there any size limitations within the Portfolio?

Yes. Standard glass panels can reach sizes up to 72" x 144". The maximum height for photographic-based images is 120" with width dependant on the image. Please discuss your size requirements with your Skyline representative.

# What is the size of sampling for the Portfolio?

The Digital Glass Portfolio's standard sample size is 4" x 8".

## What type of glass is used in Digital Glass Portfolio products?

Digital Glass Portfolio images are produced low-iron PPG Starphire® tempered safety glass to ensure color clarity and safety.

## What are the Portfolio's transparency options?

Digital Glass Portfolio images are produced with translucent AST™ I/Etch or opaque AST III/Vitracolor® for a wide spectrum of transparency and opacity. In contrast to lamination and ceramic ink, which are essentially opacifiers, our AST printing provides for a true read of light and color.

Specify Option D, AST I/Etch for translucent and/or back-lit applications through which light can pass, such as space dividers and feature walls. Design is printed on one side, but can be viewed from both sides of glass.

Specify Option E, AST III/Vitracolor for opaque wall-mount or wall-clad applications, including feature walls. Design is printed on one side, and can be viewed from one side of glass.

## Explain the durability of digital printing.

Our AST printing processes are recognized as some of the most durable in the industry. Like modern-day automotive paint finishes, our Portfolio products handle general use and wear with ease.

#### Explain the resolution limitations.

The final resolution of Digital Glass Portfolio designs will depend on the original image quality and final output size, in conjunction with the technological capability of production equipment. Resolution may vary based on application, but sampling can be done at the time of specification for client review.

# Are there any color limitations in Portfolio designs?

Ideally we prefer Portfolio products to remain true to the artwork provided in the current collection, however if custom colors are desired please contact your Skyline representative to review your requirements.
