

TEXTILE CLEANING GUIDELINES

To prevent overall soiling, frequent vacuuming or light brushing with a non-metallic, stiff bristle brush to remove dust and grime is recommended.

When cleaning a spill, blot immediately to remove spilled material. Clean spots or stains from the outside to the middle of the affected area to prevent circling.

Overall cleaning by a professional furniture cleaning service only is recommended. Pile fabrics may require brushing with a non-metallic stiff bristle brush to restore appearance.

Cleaning Codes

W – Water

Clean only with water based shampoo or foam upholstery cleaner and rinse well. Do not over wet.

W/S - Water/ Solvent

Clean only with water based shampoo or foam upholstery cleaner and rinse well. Do not over wet.

You may use S - Solvent cleaning instructions.

S – Solvent

Only mild, pure and water free dry cleaning solvents may be used for cleaning in a well-ventilated area. Do not saturate.

DO NOT USE WATER. Use of water based or detergent based solvent cleaners may cause excessive shrinkage and staining. Water stains may become permanent and impossible to remove with solvent cleaning agents.
