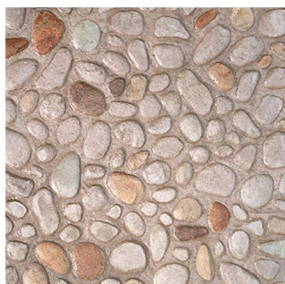


RIVER PEBBLE
RANDOM INTERLOCKING PATTERN
ORDER NUMBER 432 A,B,C

**Texture Description:**

Surface texture is that of round, smooth river pebbles. Edges of pebbles are rounded and worn.

Pattern Description:

Pattern is formed of river pebbles in various sizes laid in a random manner. The sides of the pebbles vary from 7/8" (22 mm) to 4-5/8" (117 mm). Inside joints have the appearance of a rough grouted joint, approximately 1/8" (3 mm) to 1-1/8" (29 mm) by approximately 3/8" deep. Outside edges have a surrounding joint, approximately 1/16" (1.5 mm) to 3/4" (19 mm) wide. The completed pattern is formed by use of three tools, A, B, and C, each with a different random arrangement of pebbles.

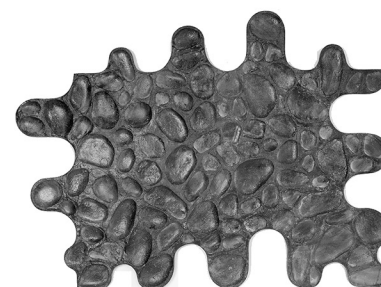
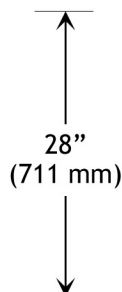

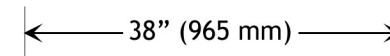
