

### **HISTORY**

Designed by Mogens Koch in 1928

Mogens Koch was the first architect in Denmark to make a flexible book case system for storage.

The first book case (76x76x27.5cm) was designed in 1928. At that time this kind of flexibility was truly revolutionary.

The solid wood storage system has been produced at Rud. Rasmussen since 1932.

### **DESCRIPTION**

The Mogens Koch bookcase system is a true Danish design classic. It has been manufactured for 80 years, providing one of the most elegant and timeless storage systems in the world.

It is a true example of Danish craftsmanship at its very best.

The cabinet has four sections - two slim sections to the left and two wide sections to the right

It always measures; 76cm x 76cm x 36cm (D).

The cabinet is very versatile and can be used in the kitchen, the living room, at the office, in the corridor etc.

The pre-drilled holes make it easy to fit in extra shelves nr. I to the left side of the cabinet or shelve nr. II for the right side of the cabinet.

The extra shelves can be ordered together with the cabinet or later, should the need arise.

If ordering the shelves with the cabinet it is necessary to specify where the shelves should be placed in the cabinet.

The shelves are easy to place in to the pre-drilled holes using the accompanying special bars. The cabinet can be wall hung or placed on base nr. 2.

Mogens Koch, who is especially known for his furniture classics such as the bookcase system and the Folding programme, worked with Kaare Klint in 1925-30, and was professor at Kunstakademiets Arkitektskole in Copenhagen in 1950-68. Mogens Koch's furniture design forms part of some of the most elegant and important solutions in terms of meeting the requirements to comfort, function and aesthetics and his furniture has been key to Rud. Rasmussen's production since 1932.

None of them came into existence as artistic manifestos but arose from a given assignment and were created for a particular purpose. Thus, his bookcase was at first designed for his private home in Hulgårdsvej near Bellahøj in Copenhagen.

The small rooms in people's houses required a flexible bookcase or cabinet and in 1928 he drew the first sketches for the square bookcase which in the relatively small module of 76 cm x 76 cm provided great and varied functional usage.


