Technical details

Function

The Stitz is a leaning aid with infinitely variable height adjustment by means of an encapsulated gas lift.

Frame

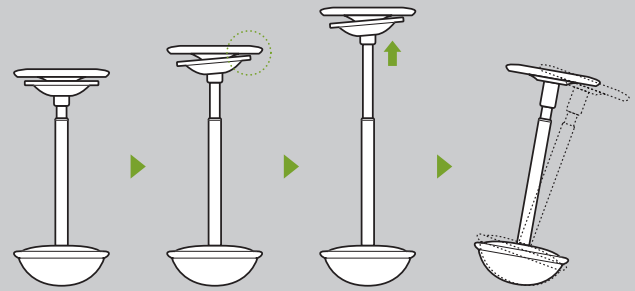
Base comprising a pouch in black, non-slip elastomer, filled with quartz sand. Cover in black, through-dyed polyamide.

Seat

Seat frame in black, through-dyed polyamide. Natural cork inset, hard-wax treated or covered in black embossed leather. Gas lift operated by pressing a disc in black, through-dyed polyamide with all-round access underneath the seat.

Additional options for cover of seat on request.

Stitz is a leaning aid with a base comprising an elastomer pouch filled with quartz sand: it adapts to any movement and even staunchly stands its ground when not in use.

A gas lift, which is operated by pressing a disc with all-round access underneath the seat, allows infinitely variable adjustment of the support height between 65 and 90 cm.



Stitz 2. Perfect balance, day in day out.

The Stitz leaning aid opens up a new dimension of mobility. It involves neither sitting nor standing, but a position in between. Stitz stands for an ingenious idea of relieving physical strain while allowing movement. The Stitz requires three legs – it needs yours too. That is why the user does not sit on a Stitz in a conventional vertical position but simply rests on its seat at an incline with his feet firmly on the ground. This causes the pelvis to adopt an upright position, facilitates metabolic functions, increases one's sense of balance and activates muscles without subjecting them to excess strain. The Stitz provides a perfect answer to complex ergonomic questions concerning the balance between concentration and movement.

The round seat surface allows access from any side. The base comprises an elastomer pouch, filled with quartz sand, allowing the Stitz to be tilted without toppling over. Last but not least, the operating disc, with all-round access underneath the seat, allows infinitely variable adjustment of the support height by means of an integral gas lift.

Black, through-dyed, high performance materials ensure that scratches and dents are hardly visible even after a long service life.

For an office or a studio, a professional practice or a presentation at a lectern – the “leaning aid” is a useful means of support for all those who do not necessarily want to sit while on the job, but do not want to be left standing either.
