


Figure 1 24" Wide Tables




Figure 2 30/36" Wide Tables



Assemble units as described herein only. To do otherwise may result in instability. All screws, nuts and bolts must be tightened securely and must be checked periodically after assembly. Failure to assemble properly, or to secure parts may result in assembly failure and injury. **Note:** When ganging 24" wide tables, the ganging hook and peg locations are at the front and center (Figure 1). When ganging 30" & 36" tables, use the front and rear hook and peg mounting locations (Figure 2). Take note of the correct orientation of the ganging hooks to assure proper latching for each type of installation.

- 1. As illustrated, and based on the table width, position the two ganging hooks as shown, at the underside of the table. Install two hooks to the first table using two pegs and #14 x 11/4" wood screws (Figure 1 or 2).
- 2. Install two pegs to the second table, in line with the first set of pegs (Figure 1 or 2).
- 3. Move tables together and swing the ganging hooks of the first table to securely engage the pegs under the second table (Figure 3).
