### GLASS CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS FOR KI ARCHITECTURAL WALLS

KI architectural wall glass products are very easy to maintain. Unless otherwise instructed by a KI Sales Specialist, it is recommended to clean with warm water and a lint-free cloth (terry cloth). Conventional, non-abrasive glass cleaners may also be used with a lint-free cloth. All strongly alkaline caustic solutions as well as acids, especially hydrofluoric acid, and cleaners containing fluorides are unsuitable.

Cleaning should begin with wetting the glass surface with clean water or a mild soap solution to loosen dirt. Using a neutral, non-abrasive commercial window washing solution, uniformly apply the solution to the glass surface with a brush, sponge, or other non-abrasive applicator.

Immediately following the application of the cleaning solution, use a squeegee or lint-free cloth towel to remove all of the cleaning solution from the glass. Care should be taken to ensure that no abrasive particles are trapped between the glass and the cleaning materials. All water and cleaning solution residue should be dried immediately from gaskets, sealants, and frames to avoid the potential deterioration of these materials.

It is strongly recommended to clean a small glass area or one window at a time, then stop and examine the surface for any undesirable impact to the glass.
