

INSTALLATION

- 1. Turn off power supply where unit is to be installed.
- 2. Access the LED board in the EXIT.
- On the printed circuit board, locate the 2 pin plug labeled CN3 and FAI. Connect the supplied wire harness to this plug.
- Connect the wire harness to the fire alarm system, either AC or DC, using wire nuts. For DC operation, the red wire is positive.
- 5. Reassemble the EXIT as necessary.
