


Benefits of grazing

Benefits of wallwashing


- Smooth, even illumination


Asymmetric applications



Optic: Asymmetric Wallwash

No. of luminaires: 3



Spacing: 2ft. Setback: 2ft.

Avg. illuminance: 11.9 fc



Spacing: 1.5ft. Setback: 1.5ft.

Avg. illuminance: 20.2 fc



Spacing: 2ft. Setback: 1 ft.

Avg. illuminance: 36.3 fc



Spacing: 1.5ft. Setback: 6 in.

Avg. illuminance: 85.4 fc

Rule of thumb

Setback: Recommended setback from the wall is 1/10 of the wall height.

Spacing: Appropriate spacing between luminaires may be up to two times the set-

back distance.

Computerized photometric calculations are recommended to validate illuminance and uniformity.

Spacing: 4ft. Setback: 2ft.

Avg. illuminance: 8.9 fc



Spacing: 3ft. Setback: 1.5ft.

Avg. illuminance: 15.9 fc



Spacing: 3 ft. Setback: 1 ft.

Avg. illuminance: 31.3 fc



Spacing: 3 ft. Setback: 6 in.

Avg. illuminance: 68.2 fc

Rule of thumb

Setback: Recommended setback from the wall is 1/10 of the wall height.
