



a collection of furniture

Zones is more than another "product line".

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enclosures

Enclosures make it possible to create semi-enclosed, focused or collaborative settings.

They can be:

- Lounge or table based
- Planned for sitting or standing
- Support digital and/or analog tools



work tables

Work tables are available in a variety of shapes and sizes and are equally suitable for touchdown or hot-desking scenarios.

- Canteen Tables are used for informal non traditional meetings
- Bistro Tables are used as a casual touch down area
- Workshop Tables are used for fully engaged project centered meeting areas
- Ledge Tables are available

Casual Tables are available in heights that promote various styles of interaction.

- Bases provide an aesthetic tie to Solo Lounge, Club and Side/Arm Chairs and Stools

accessories

Zones Accessories can be used throughout a floor plan.

- Easels and Tech Easels provide a portable writing surface as well as adding technology to an open space
- Coat Stand and Coatcheck Easel store personal clothing items to help keep a space organized



lighting

Zones ambient lighting creates a cozy, inviting atmosphere.

They can be used:

- In an Enclosure or Screen mounted
- Table mounted
- Freestanding in an open floor plan or meeting space



multi-use seating

Zones Multi-Use Seating can be used with Tables, Enclosures or Screens to create settings that cater to users functional needs and designers aesthetic visions.

- The curved leg detail coordinates with Work and Casual Tables and Easels


The Zones furniture collection is designed as an alternative to the traditional office.

8 workstation area

- Add a Focus Zone-Twin Enclosure
 - By condensing workstation size, focused spaces can be created

- Add Zones Semi-Supported Worksurface for upStage Integration, Corner Desk Edge Screens and Semi-Supported Worksurface Support Kit
 - Allows for the Zones aesthetic to be integrated into workstation planning

what is zones

health & wellness

Zones expresses an approach to design that recognizes the human need for spaces that are both practical and pleasurable to inhabit, that help people to feel at home – in the office

- Workers at home are typically in constant flux rather than remaining stationary. This constant movement and changing posture throughout the day promotes healthy ergonomics
- Zones, too, encourages changing postures, enabling users to lounge, work, rest, relax, stand, sit, meet and perch

Low casual seating and tables allow for a relaxed posture which creates a casual space to read, take a quick phone call or have a brief informal meeting.



The 25" high Dialogue Workshop Table used with the upright position provided by a Zones Conference Lounge Chair allows for casual meeting spaces where a more informal and relaxed posture can be created.



A 29" high task height table and work chairs allow for proper seated posture where you can work, have formal meetings and be fully engaged for longer periods of time.



The 36" high counter height tables provide the ability for two people to converse at the correct eye level while one is sitting and one is standing.



The 42" high bar height tables and chairs allow for proper seated posture and also allows one to stand and be at the proper worksurface height. This can allow for casual seating or quick impromptu meeting spaces.



understanding enclosures & screens

Zones Enclosures and Screens consist of screen segments and trims that Flat Fabric Buffers, Quilted Fabric Buffers, Worksurfaces, Seating, Lighting and Accessories attach to. The Enclosure or Screen is specified as one complete unit. Buffers, Worksurfaces, Supports, Seating and Accessories are specified separately.

1 Screen segment:

- Constructed of laminated plywood, 6mm thick
- Secured to the vertical metal trim and wood enclosure and screen segment trims
- All screen segments are included, the Enclosure or Screen type will determine the size and number required

2 Vertical metal trim:

- Painted aluminum extrusions that are bonded to the screen segment

3 Enclosure and Screen trim:


- Constructed of solid beech, 20mm thick
- Wraps around the top, bottom and ends of an Enclosure or Screen
- All segments of trim are included, the Enclosure or Screen type will determine the location and number required

4 Wing segment:


- Provides various levels of privacy
- Available with or without partial heights slots

5 Feet:

- Elevate the Enclosure or Screen 64mm for a visual lightness
- Provide 38mm of leveling
- Enable casual power routing under an Enclosure or Screen



understanding enclosures & screens (continued)

**6 Flat and Quilted Fabric Buffers**

- Provide a textured visual softness and an implied acoustic feel
- Available partial or full height for Flat Fabric Buffers
- Available partial height for Quilted Buffers
- Available for interior and exterior applications

7 Worksurfaces:

- Size and shape are specific to each Enclosure
- Attach directly to the screen segment with brackets or are mounted to a support kit in freestanding applications

8 Support kits:

- Clamp onto the vertical metal trim to provide semi-suspended support to worksurfaces
- Include a power cable manager
- Ordered as kits, the Enclosure type will determine the number and type required

9 Soft Seating:

- Provides a freestanding sofa within an Enclosure or Screen
- Does not offer structural support to the Enclosure or Screen

10 Sofa tablets:

- Constructed of birch plywood finished with Zones laminates or veneers
- Attach to sofas and provide a secondary surface for coffee and notebooks
- Do not attach to the Enclosure or Screen

11 Lighting

- Table Lamps can be freestanding or can be mounted through the worksurface
- Sconces attach to the vertical metal trim


The following should be considered when planning with Enclosures.



Enclosures are specified as complete units. All screens and vertical metal trims are pre-assembled into modules.



Custom configurations are not possible.




The handedness of an enclosure is determined by the location of the slots on the wing as seen when looking into the Enclosure from the entrance.

If no slots are specified, the handedness is determined by the "Wing Panel" relative to the entrance of the Enclosure.



When a In-The-Zone Sofa – 1-Seater is specified with a tablet, it is recommended that the tablet position not be on the outer side of the Enclosure as it will interfere with entry






Enclosures **cannot** be attached to each other. They are designed to be stand alone enclosures. Two individual enclosures can be placed end to end in an application so that an "S" configuration is formed.


planning with enclosures (continued)



If planning Enclosures back-to-back, it is recommended that the shorter lengths be back-to-back together, so that the outsides can be used for other functions such as small meeting areas.




If planning Enclosures back-to-back, it is **not** recommended that the longer lengths be back-to-back together, as it does not allow space for small meeting areas.




It is not recommended that the Enclosures be clustered, the 108° angle does not nest efficiently.

general information

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fabric care & maintenance

Regular cleaning of your furniture system will maintain the appearance and optimize the long term return on investment.

Fabric

Panel and Seating fabrics are comprised of a variety of fiber construction. They are colorfast to standard wet and dry cleaning procedures. Avoid excessive brushing or rubbing during cleaning to prevent fuzzing of the fabric surface. Due to the low absorption properties, soiling will tend to remain on the fiber surface. To prevent overall soiling, frequent vacuuming or light brushing to remove dust and grime is recommended.

Oil or grease-type spots will respond to mild solvents or dry cleaning agents. When spot cleaning with a mild solvent or dry cleaning agent, follow instructions carefully and clean only in a well ventilated room. Avoid any product which contains carbon tetrachloride or other toxic materials. The blotting technique, without rubbing, should be sufficient to remove most spots.

To remove general dirt or grime spots, sponge with the foam from a mild detergent or upholstery shampoo. Rinse well with a clean sponge to remove traces of the water-based cleaning agent.

When spot cleaning with either the water-base or solvent-base type cleaning agents, test a small inconspicuous area before proceeding to spot clean the fabric any further. If an overall soiled condition has been reached, contact a professional furniture cleaning service.

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Leather

Clean leather with a damp cloth and mild soap using light, circular motions. Repeat the process with a clean moist cloth and allow the leather to dry. A soft, dry cloth can then be used to polish the leather. Do not clean leather with detergents.

Ultra Durable

Cleaning Ultra Durable vinyl for most stains is achieved by prompt, energetic washing using a sponge and warm, soapy water, clear water rinses or a mild, non-abrasive cleaner. Moderate scrubbing with a medium bristle brush will help to loosen soiling materials from the depressions of embossed surfaces but have not penetrated the vinyl surface.

Advanced Cleaning Methods

Use the following commercially available mild detergents in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions, *Formula 409*®, *Fantastik*®, or *Mr. Clean*®. When opening a new container, please test the cleaner in an inconspicuous area as cleaner manufacturers may change formula without notice.

Full strength rubbing alcohol or mineral spirits may be tried with caution if the commercially available cleaners do not work. Indiscriminate use of strong solvents can severely damage or discolor Ultra Durable vinyl.

Ultra Durable offers enhanced resistance to most of the common chemicals used for sterilization and cleaning in medical environments. Ultra Durable will resist, without serious discoloration, the repeated action of normal dilutions of chlorine bleaches, ammonia based cleaners, excluding Quaternary Ammonium Compounds and Phenolics, as well as many common oxidizing and reducing chemicals.

Bleach can be diluted up to 9:1 ratio (10%). Liberally apply diluted disinfectant using a sponge, rinse with cold water several times, and then wipe dry. Repeat if necessary. Federal regulation requires that guidelines on the bleach label need to be followed for antiseptic or antimicrobial purposes.

teknipaint & teknistain**TekniPaint**

A TekniPaint form is required if the customer requires a custom paint color. Custom paint is applicable to metal and seamless product.

The color matching procedures will take a minimum of 10 working days.

Standard lead times apply once customer approved sample is received by Teknion Customer Service Representative.

Using the TekniPaint

Prior to placing the order, Dealer submits the color match sample (minimum size 2" x 2") to Teknion Customer Service Representative in conjunction with a completed TekniPaint form.

After the color match process is completed, two (2) samples are returned to the Paint and Stain Coordinator who forwards them to the Dealer with a sign-off sticker, attached to the back of the sample, for approval by the customer.

Customer formally signs-off on the color samples by signing the attached sticker.

Dealer returns one (1) of the customer approved samples to a Customer Service Representative or a fax of the signed off sample to Teknion.

Dealer submits the order, quoting the paint name and paint number as indicated on the customer sign-off sticker.

TekniPaint forms and information on how to use these forms can be found on My Teknion, Order & Specification, Order Services, PreOrder, Order & Specification Prep, Custom Paint, Stain & Laminate for your printing convenience.

TekniStain

A TekniStain form is required if a wood product is needed in colors outside our standard offering.

Teknion requires dealer or client to supply one (1) TekniStain form for each color being custom matched.

Include three (3) for U.S./two (2) for Canada minimum 3 x 3 color samples for each color being submitted for Custom Wood Stain

Teknion will provide customer with two color samples for each TekniStain submitted. The customer must sign the back of the approved sample. The second sample to be kept for customer reference.

To order a Custom Wood Stain, follow these instructions:

If specifying a custom color for Seating, please use code NOCWS.

If specifying a custom color for District, Interpret, Leverage, Marketplace, TOS, Transit, Expansion Casegoods or Expansion Wood, please use code ZOCWS.

If specifying a custom color for Dossier, Cana, Westcoast, Table&Conferencing and Executive Casegoods, please use code ZCCWS.

Please forward a TekniStain form to your Customer Service Representative along with two color samples. Allow two (2) weeks for the TekniStain approval process. The Custom Wood Stain sample must be signed off prior to placing product order. The total lead time will begin once final approval samples have been received from customer to Teknion.



fabric pattern seam guidelines

All fabrics for Zones Modular Seating are applied Off-the-bolt (front to back). Patterned upholstery is not recommended due to the curved form and manner in which the upholstery is applied.

COMs will follow the same fabric orientation and pattern seams.

Seams are required in the centre-line of 3-seater straight upholstered benches and curved concave units as indicated below. Seams are applied to the back side and front face of the bench backs.

customer's own material (COM)

Customers Own Material or Leather (COM / COL)

A COM form is required if a Teknion product is needed in a textile outside our Standard or Graded-In Programs. For any COM/COL requests, please check with Teknion Customer Service for a record of the test results. If the fabric/leather has been approved, a serial number for the fabric and a cutting direction will be supplied by Teknion. This number must be shown on the order. Please note, for various reasons, certain fabrics/leathers may not be approved for use. The required COM/COL yardages given on the price pages are for orders up to 100 chairs. This number is approximate and can vary depending on the pattern repeat.

The COM process will take a minimum of 5 working days once the test yardage has been received by Teknion.

COM forms and information on how to use these forms can be found on My Teknion, Order & Specifacaton, Order Services, PreOrder, Customize, COM, for your printing convenience.

NOTE: Applying the fabric pattern to a rendering may **not** accurately represent the actual product.

COM Pattern Directional Guidelines for Seating

Usually, seating fabrics are patterned to run Off-the-Bolt. At the request of the customer, upholstery can be applied railroaded but yardage requirements may vary.

To avoid unnecessary confusion, you must always specify Off-the-Bolt or railroaded when using a COM fabric.

Due to Zones Modular Seating part geometry and compound surfaces of curved units, fabric patterns with vertical lines will **not** always appear truly vertical and may also show lines converging/diverging on seams at certain points.

It must be noted that the vertical pattern repeat on the fabric may not match exactly from unit to unit, due to the fabric pattern repeat size and also the need for seams on the adjacent units.

See Fabric Pattern Seam Guidelines earlier in this section for more information.

Estimated Material Requirement

COM yardage shown on each products COM/COL Material Requirement Chart is based on unpatterned (plain) fabrics only.

More yardage may be required depending upon the upholstery pattern, repeat, directionality and pattern matching. Leather yield varies from 60-80% and may be affected by the quality of the COL including location and quantity of blemishes, size and shape of hide. The size of the sewing pattern and the number of units ordered may also impact yield. Always round-up to the next yard or hide for each unit that is specified prior to calculating. For larger unit quantities, additional hides may be required.

COL Hide Calculation

When calculating the number of hides required, one must first understand the hide square footage from the chosen COL supplier as the size of leather hides vary by region and by line.

It is not possible to achieve 100% yield optimum due to the nature of hides having various configurations, blemishes and scars, as well as the individual chairs part sizes and part dimensions. Customer order size may also impact yield. Hide calculation requires use of the smallest hide size and applying a yield factor of 70% utilization in order to estimate the usable square footage.

As an example, a supplier of hides from a particular region may advise that their hides vary in size from 55-60 square feet. Hide calculation is required to use the smallest hide size (55 square feet in this case) and apply a yield factor of 70% utilization.

When the square footage required for each chair is **less than the usable square footage of (1X) hide**:

SAMPLE CASE A:

26 chairs are to be ordered and the COL Material Requirement Chart indicates 16.5 square feet COL is required per chair. The smallest hide size identified by the supplier is 55 square feet.

$55 \text{ square feet} \times 70\% \text{ yield} = 38.5 \text{ square feet usable hide size}$

$38.5 \text{ square feet usable hide size} \div 16.5 \text{ square feet required per chair} = 2.33 \text{ chairs per hide}$

Round down the number of chairs produced from a hide = 2 chairs per hide

For 26 units, divide by 2 chairs per hide = 13 hides

A total of 13 hides are estimated to complete the order.

When the square footage required for each chair is **greater than the usable square footage of (1X) hide**:

SAMPLE CASE B:

2 sofas are to be ordered and the COL Material Requirement Chart indicates 88 square feet COL is required per sofa. The smallest hide size identified by the supplier is 55 square feet.

$55 \text{ square feet} \times 70\% = 38.5 \text{ square feet usable hide size}$

$38.5 \text{ square feet usable hide size} \div 88 \text{ square feet required per sofa} = 0.44 \text{ sofas per hide}$

For 1 unit $\div 0.44 \text{ chairs per hide} = 2.27 \text{ hides to create (1x) sofa}$

Round up to 3 hides per sofa

To calculate for (2x) units, multiply by 2




Railroaded application (RR)

Regular cleaning of your furniture system will maintain the appearance and optimize the long term return on investment.

Zones Seating

Due to the unique shape and size of Zones Seating and the inherent properties of some fabrics, mild creasing or puckering may result and is not considered a quality issue by Teknion. In most cases, the fabric can be smoothed-over by hand to improve the appearance.

Whiteboard

Cleaning

We recommend that you erase your whiteboard after every use.

If you need to leave the content on your board then we recommend that the whiteboards should at least be cleaned weekly with the wet whiteboard cleaner recommend by the related marker manufacturer.

Cleaning your whiteboard will remove the chemical build-up that can occur with repeated use of dry erase markers. This can help maintain your whiteboard.

Maintenance

Use Dry erase markers only. All dry erase markers can write legibly on a whiteboard surface, but not all will erase properly due to their composition. Do not use low odor dry erase markers or permanent (indelible) markers. The use of proper markers can help avoid staining or ghosting.

Follow the Cleaning recommendations. It is recommended that the whiteboard is erased daily using an eraser designated for use with dry erase markers from the marker manufacturer. We also recommend that a complete cleaning is performed at least once a week with the wet whiteboard cleaner recommend by the related marker manufacturer.

To remove permanent marker. Write on top of the permanent marker, erase with a dry eraser, using a dry erase marker, and then clean with the wet whiteboard cleaner recommend by the related marker manufacturer.

Ghosting Issues

Faded content that remains on your whiteboard after erasing/cleaning is commonly known as ghosting.

To help avoid ghosting, do not use permanent or non-dry erase markers. Avoid using red and orange markers for easier cleaning and to reduce the likelihood of ghosting.

In order to avoid ghosting please use our cleaning and maintenance recommendations. If ghosting remains please try of the following actions to remove

Apply whiteboard cleaner and wipe entire whiteboard with a paper towel, and let dry. Use Mix Joy® dishwashing detergent with warm water and apply to the whiteboard using a paper towel, then wipe dry with a clean cloth. Repeat as necessary.

If ghosting or staining remains, you could use a small amount of rubbing alcohol on a clean, soft towel.

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Metal & Plastic

Wash surface regularly with mild soap and water. Dry with a clean cloth or soft paper towel to prevent soap streaks.

Source Laminate & Fascia Laminate

In order to maintain the life and appearance of your thermally fused melamine panels, please follow these guidelines:

- May be easily cleaned using a mild, non-abrasive, all purpose cleaner and a soft cloth. Coffee, tea or other difficult stains may be removed using a mild household detergent or a paste of baking soda and water (note: 10-20 strokes should remove most stains, excessive force or scrubbing may damage the surface).
- Abrasives such as scouring pads or gritty cleansers may permanently dull and /or scratch the surface and result in future staining.
- Do not place hot cookware, dishes or objects onto the surface. Knives and other sharp objects used directly on the surface can also be damaging.

Foundation Laminate

High pressure laminate (HPL) surfaces are highly resistant to wear, scratching, boiling water, food acids, alcohols, oil, grease and ordinary household chemicals.

General Care

Surfaces will retain their original appearance indefinitely when these simple precautions are followed:

- Wash surface with a non-residual, streak free cleaning product such as glass cleaner (ammonia based cleaner) to remove residue (oils, fingerprints, glass rings, smudges and smears).
- To remove superficial stains which may not be easily removed with soap and water, use a non-abrasive liquid cleaner.
- Use of an eraser can assist in the removal of ink marks.
- Avoid gritty or abrasive liquid cleaners and cleansing powders.
- Avoid bleaching cleaners and cleansing powders.
- Use a wooden cutting board when cutting, slicing or chopping.
- Use a trivet or hot pad under appliances.

Seamless Color

Surfaces will retain their original appearance indefinitely when these simple precautions are followed:

- Wash surface regularly with mild soap and water. Dry with a clean cloth or soft paper towel to prevent soap streaks.
- To remove superficial stains which may not be easily removed with soap and water, use a non-abrasive liquid cleaner.

Flintwood & Natural Veneer

Teknion furniture is built to strict specifications to ensure many years of exceptional use. Like all natural products, Teknion wood surfaces may vary slightly in grain texture and color. Because each piece of furniture is unique, minor variations between pieces can be expected.

The beauty of Teknion's veneer is enhanced with a clear top coat which is not affected by most liquids found in offices or homes. This finish contains inhibitors to help prevent pigments from fading. However, like any wood product, the finish will fade with prolonged exposure to intense light.

Cleaning & Polishing

To clean, simply wipe the surface (in the direction of the grain) first with a dry cloth. Circular or sideways rubbing can adversely affect the appearance of the wood finish. If the surface is exceptionally dirty, add a mild soap solution to the water. Waxes and furniture polishes should be avoided as they may result in buildup or may deepen the gloss of the furniture.

General Care

- Remove any spilled liquids immediately with a blotting rather than a wiping action.
- Do not drag objects across finished surfaces.
- For chips, scratches or unusual damage, professional repair may be required.
- Avoid exposing the surface to extreme heat, cold or humidity.
- The surface finish may be burn-resistant but the wood beneath the finish is not and can be charred (e.g. by a burning cigarette).
- Exposure to strong sunlight should be avoided. The surface finish is fade proof but the wood beneath may change in color from extended exposure to sunlight.
- Place a desk pad under mechanical equipment. Rubber and oil will permanently mark the surface.
- Dust the surface frequently with a clean, soft, dry cloth.

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Solid Surface

Routinely clean with a damp cloth. If a stain develops, wipe it with soap and water, or if you prefer wipe it clean with glass cleaner.

Do not expose your solid surface worksurface to harsh chemicals.


For tough stains, apply an abrasive cleanser and buff with a Scotch-Brite® pad using a circular motion.



Touch-Up Kit Directions

Before You Begin

Make sure the surface is clean, dry and free of grease and oil. If needed, use a mild solvent and a clean cloth to wipe down surface. NOTE: Touch-Up should be used on small nicks and scratches only. It is not meant for large areas or deep gouges.

How to Use the Small Brush (KT100)

Always shake the bottle for at least one minute after the mixing balls begin to rattle. If the product is not adequately mixed, the color of the paint will not be correct. (Do not try to get all of the residue on the bottom of the bottle; it will never totally blend). Make sure that the product is capped tightly before shaking.

Dip brush into the bottle as far as it will go.

Slowly remove the brush from the bottle. The brush wiper which is mounted in the bottle opening reduces the opening diameter and helps to wipe excess paint from the brush. This eliminates dripping paint from the brush after removing it from the bottle.

Brush paint on with smooth strokes. Use very slight pressure when touching the brush to the substrate. Avoid retouching the wet paint film with the brush after it is applied. Do not try to retouch applied paint after paint has set up for more than 2 minutes.

When finished, recap the bottle.

How to Use the Crayon (KT401)

Apply by simply rubbing the semi-hard compound into the defect or damaged substrate or finish in a variety of directions.

Once applied, and slightly overfilled, the excess filler is removed by carefully leveling off using a semi-flexible plastic leveling card. An old bank card works sufficiently for this step. To finish off the task, use a soft lint free cloth for wiping off any further excess material from the area being worked on. Paper towel can also be substituted for a lint free cloth and this purpose.

How to Use the Marker (KT402)

Shake marker thoroughly to get full color strength. Depress the nib to begin material flow. Do not overload the nib with material. With light strokes, slowly apply color to the damaged area being careful not to "puddle" the material. Gently feather the applied material with a finger to blend the color in with the surrounding area.
