

User information Care and cleaning

## Intended purpose

The HEWI rail system is designed for use in bathrooms. It provides a gripping option for persons with or without physical disability when they shower or take a bath

- Do not treat metal components with objects containing iron (e.g. scourer sponge, steel wool).


Disposal of the product and packaging is subject to the relevant national regulations.

Too wide support spacings will reduce the stability of the grab rail and wall supports and may lead to injuries due to falling. Observe maximum support spacings.




CAUTION!

Exceeding the maximum load of the grab rails may lead to injuries due to falling. Observe maximum load.


Ensure that the wall structure and fixings permanently withstand the expected load. Lightweight construction walls must be appropriately lined at the back.




Any improper use, e.g. as a gymnastic apparatus or climbing aid, may lead to injuries due to slipping or falling.

Use grab rails only for support.


















When joining the rails, note the sticker and hold the rails at right-angles to each other.







Use extended bit acceptances (approx. 4 in) for electric screwdrivers or similar as otherwise the chuck may damage the surface!
