





### **Steelcase**

- **1.** First, extend the cylinder to the highest position using the seat height lever.
- **2.** Next, lay chair on its side. Hit bottom of the cylinder with a hammer (2a) while pulling forward on the chair base (2b).

**TIP:** Turn hammer sideways so as to not hit cylinder rod.

3. Remove chair base.







**NOTE:** DO NOT hit the inner cylinder rod with the hammer. Hit the outer rim of the cylinder.
