BARBER AND OSGERBY COMPACT LOUNGE COLLECTION The Collection includes an arm chair and a two-seat sofa, scaled for the workplace and features a lower back and reduced seat depth. Available in a range of upholstery fabrics and leathers, the lounge furniture is distinguished by stitched seams that reinforce its architectural profile and softened by the curvature of cushions on each face. The signature cast aluminum leg of the furniture can be specified in chrome and painted finishes.

EDWARD BARBER AND JAY OSGERBY Internationally acclaimed designers Edward Barber and Jay Osgerby founded their studio in 1996 after graduating with Master's degrees in Architecture from The Royal College of Art in London. Alongside their eponymous studio, in 2001 Barber and Osgerby founded Universal Design Studio, now recognized as one of the world's most innovative creative design consultancies working in architecture, interiors and exhibition design. BarberOsgerby's work is held in permanent collections around the world including the V&A Museum, London; New York's Metropolitan Museum of Art; London's Design Museum; and the Art Institute of Chicago. Edward and Jay have been recognized in the Queen's Birthday Honours and awarded OBEs for their services to the design industry.



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
