




CAUTION

Do not stack in a nested arrangement











- **1.** Extend height of chair and place it upside-down on a support surface that will not scratch the shell (such as a desk).
- **2.** Drill pilot hole at each pilot point (6X) with an approximately 1/8" drill bit.
- **3.** Use a 3/8" bit to enlarge hole to proper diameter.

- **4.** Align cushion to chair shell so that the bosses of the cushion fit inside the holes of the chair shell.
- **5.** With a T-30 hand driver, loose secure the cushion in one of the corners.
- **6.** Tightly secure (16 in-lbs) a screw in the opposite corner. If power drill is used, do not have your drive in "drill" mode.
- **7.** Secure all other screws, including the loose screw from Step 5.



## **CAUTION:**

Do not drill into (or damage) your support surface.

Torque screws to 16 in-lbs. Hand driver recommended. If power driver is used, do not use "drill" mode.
