Fletcher has the jaunty appearance and smooth comfort that calls to mind the orchestral jazz the chair's namesake, Fletcher Henderson, pioneered in New York in the 1920s. Two-inch-thick foam seat cushions and an upholstered back make sitting a truly enjoyable experience. A hard maple frame made with mortise-and-tenon construction ensures strength that complements the chair's simple, straight-ahead beauty.

Guest chair featuring an upholstered seat and an upholstered back. The frame is hard maple, mortise-and-tenon and doweled construction with corner blocking reinforcing legs and rails. Legs have Nylon glides. The seat is 2" thick multi-density polyurethane foam wrapped in Dacron® over webbing that is stretched over a hardwood plywood frame. Catalyzed lacquer finish in all Cumberland Maple finishes. Also available in an armless version.
