

## Maintenance and Cleaning Instructions

- All impressed and solid tiles should be handled with care to avoid surface damage of the textile.
- Avoid aggressively rubbing or scrubbing motion as this may change the surface appearance.
- Never use anything hot to clean fabric, as heat will set stains.
- For minimal dust or lint, removal with a lint roller is suggested.
- Occasional light vacuuming is recommended for excessive dust or lint. Please Note: Vacuuming should be done
  with the proper attachments to avoid fiber damage, pilling or altering the surface appearance.
- Spot clean as needed using a water based cleaning agent and foam or mild water free solvent.
- There are two types of stains: water based and oil-based. The key to removing either type is prompt action. The longer the stain is allowed to remain on a fabric, the more difficult it will be to remove.
- Blot fresh spills as soon as possible to avoid the liquid absorbing in to the tile, but do not dry completely or else stain may set.
- Most water based stains can be cleaned using a white lint free cloth dampened, but not over saturate with water and a mild soap. Using the treated cloth, blot the stain starting from the outer edge and moving inward to avoid creating rings. Renew the cleaning cloth after each application of solution. Repeat process until the spot is completely removed or until this is no further transfer of the stain on the cloth.
- Oil-based stains can follow the same process but instead of warm water, a spray dry cleaning solution is used.
- Once the stain is removed, soak up all remaining cleaning solution and then use clean cloth or sponge dipped in cool water to remove any residue that will attract further soiling.
- Refer to chart for stain specific cleaner removal recommendations: "W-S" or "W" Fabrics

Stain	Recommended Cleaner(s)
Carbon, Catsup, chocolate, coffee, cola, grape	50/50 solution of warm water and hydrogen peroxide or sodium
juice, inks, mucilage, tea, watercolors, wine	perborate (Snowy/Chlorox) or detergent (Era/All/Gain)
Berry stain, gravy, pickle juice, urine, vomit	50/50 solution of warm water and hydrogen peroxide or sodium; urine, vomit perborate (Snowy/Chlorox) or detergent
	(Era/All/Gain); or detergent solution and water solution with 3% ammonia
Beer, furniture polish	50/50 solution of warm water and hydrogen peroxide or sodium perborate (Snowy/Chlorox) or detergent (Era/All/Gain); or detergent solution and water solution with 3% ammonia; or undiluted white vinegar; or 10% acetic acid solution
Blood	50/50 solution of warm water and hydrogen peroxide or sodium perborate (Snowy/Chlorox) or detergent (Era/All/Gain); or undiluted white vinegar; or 10% acetic acid solution
Nail polish	50/50 solution of warm water and hydrogen peroxide or sodium perborate (Snowy/Chlorox) or detergent (Era/All/Gain); or solvent
Egg	Detergent solution and water solution with 3% ammonia
Butter	Detergent solution and water solution with 3% ammonia; or paint, oil, grease remover
Milk	Undiluted white vinegar or 10% acetic acid solution
Rubber cement, shoe polish	Solvent
Crayon, Latex & oil paint, linseed oil, lipstick, oil	Paint, oil, grease remover
Rust	Oxalic Acid
