





## TIPS

- 1) Locate the highest point of the floor at which the first corner is assembled.
- 2) Level each panel as it is assembled. Use leveling guides. See Diagram A.
- 3) Make sure all rivets of a horizontal rail have been seated before installing the next horizontal rail. See Diagram B.Note: Tile hooks cannot be installed if rivets are not seated properly.Hint: If the bottom rivets are difficult to line up, use a quick release clamp to hold them in place while pounding with a mallet.
  - Hint: Bottom horizontal rails can be removed without using a mallet. Use a 3/8" large, flat blade screwdriver to pry the horizontal rail up. See Diagram C.
- 4) Use flat washers with shoulder bolts to attach vertical half posts to aluminum corner connector blocks. See STEP ONE. Hint: Set driver to low speed and highest torque setting to ensure shoulder bolts are as tight as possible.


## **STEP ONE** Construct Corner




STEP TWO Install Top Horizontal




STEP THREE Install Post




STEP FOUR Install Third Post




STEP FIVE Install Remaining Horizontals




## STEP SIX Install Tile Hooks




STEP SEVEN Install Power




STEP EIGHT Install Base Raceways
