



Its adaptive design provides exceptional layout flexibility, making it ideal for environments that require extensive segmentation, wire management, or frequent reconfiguration.



FREEDOM OF TECHNOLOGY

WireWorks gives you cable management through and around every tile. Configure panels that run wires through the tiles and along sides of windows or open frames and stack panels up to 12 feet high. Use chimney tiles in place of ceiling infeeds to eliminate unsightly power poles.

WireWorks also provides easy access to wire ways and accommodates all standard types of cables. And every WireWorks panel has plenty of interior space to store excess cabling, making future reconfiguration a breeze. You can even add power/data access tiles after installation.




- A** Notches on the ends of horizontal rails allow rails to be added or removed without disturbing any cables or adjacent panes.



- B** To shorten a panel in the middle of a run, simply lift off the top horizontal and add trim instead. Move cables to an adjacent panel by lifting and lowering the horizontal.

- A** Use the same frame for either monolithic tiles or segmented tiles. Simply add or remove horizontal rails as needed.

- B** Mix or change tiles within the same frame. Options include acoustic, tackable fabric, steel, markerboard or glass.



Each panel has plenty of interior space to store excess loops of data cable.



Lay cables through the top horizontal of each panel to accommodate up to 24 Cat 5 UTP cables.



- A** Stacking sections provide the freedom to create a private office with a door.


- B** Doors are available in standard 36" widths as well as ADA-compliant 42" widths.



Stacking sections allow panel heights to increase or decrease without disturbing wires, cables or adjacent panels.

- A** All panels can be used as a spine wall and accommodate off-module panel connectors.

- B** Segmented and half-segmented panels accommodate off-module storage and worksurface connectors.



Easily remove spine wall tiles with off-module panels that connect to the main panel with a 1" gap.








