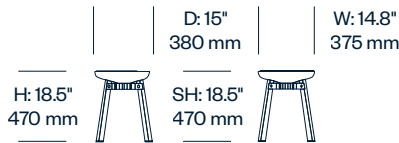

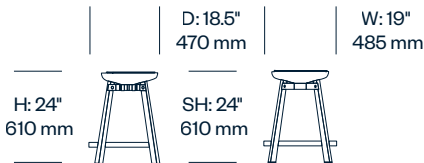

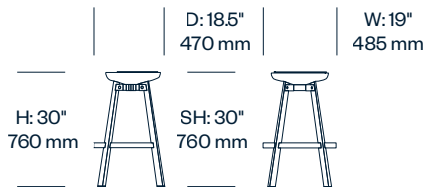
Low Stool
